## Mission

*Today's Gospel is about Jesus sending out seventy-two disciples to preach the good news of the kingdom. Every baptized person is called to spread the Gospel.*

*Jesus sends the disciples out in twos to visit all the towns and villages where He was planning to go Himself. He does not let them settle down in those places. He tells them to preach and then move on.*

*In all of this, there is a sense of movement, a strong sense of mission. He tells these missionaries not to carry any luggage, nor stop to chat on the road. They are bearing a message of peace and are to spread it to as many people as possible. They are to be grateful for the food and support that anyone gives them. They are to give healing and love to the sick and to assure them that the kingdom of God is close.*

*They are told to waste no time on those who reject their message. Their preaching is to concentrate on the essentials, so that as many people as possible are to hear it and accept it.*

*The Church, as a whole, has the double task of mission and maintenance. This is true for parishes and individuals as well. We need to ask ourselves whether our lives as Christians reflect the emphasis that Jesus and Paul, and so many others have put on the spreading of the Good News in ways that make sense to those who live alongside us.*

## Ministry of Eucharistic Visitors

Before the COVID disaster, our Parish had a Ministry of Eucharistic Visitors. These people visited the nursing homes in the area and brought the Blessed Sacrament to isolated and lonely people. I believe that it is time to renew that commitment, and I invite as many of you as possible to join me in forming such a group.

Through our current monthly catechesis, many Parishioners have been trying to heighten their understanding of the place of the Eucharist in our lives. Many of you have a great devotion to adoration. Some of you are just discovering the power of intimacy with Jesus through frequent Communion. We are all incorporated into the Church through Baptism, the reception of Holy Communion renews, strengthens, and deepens our Faith because we abide with Jesus through the Eucharist. Imagine the benefit we receive.

## Keeping Sacred Space Sacred

We have a predicament. Lately, we have experienced a housekeeping problem. We find crumbs, bits of crackers, and even used water bottles left in pews. We remind parishioners that as an act of reverence for the importance of the reception of the Blessed Sacrament, we fast from food and drink one hour before communion. This simple custom allows us to promote an attitude of attention and respect for the importance of the Eucharist.

If someone has a health issue requiring specific timing for food, or a mother has a toddler who can only be controlled with a snack, that is, of course, understandable. In such a case, we ask that you do so discreetly and that you take a moment to clean up any leftovers in consideration for the next person to use your pew and to avoid luring mice into a sacred space. No one else should be eating in church.

*It is always a good time to teach our children and to remind ourselves of the Sacredness of the Divine Presence in our Church. St. Thomas Aquinas called the Eucharist the perfect sign of the Passion of Christ. In his magnificent hymns, especially the Pange Lingua, he recommended the utmost physical and spiritual awareness we owe to God for this greatest of gifts.*
