Prayer

In the Gospels, the disciples frequently questioned Jesus. They wanted to understand more perfectly what He said and did. Sometimes, Jesus's answer would be another question, which invited further questions. The disciples were learners, and asking questions led to deeper understanding of Jesus' message. Later, they would use this learning to preach to all the nations of the world.

They noticed that on many occasions, Jesus prayed to the Father. They saw its importance, and they wanted to share in the experience. So, they asked Him how to pray. He taught them and us the Lord's Prayer.

This prayer teaches us that we must praise God and His holy name and ask that His kingdom be realized. We are encouraged to ask for what is necessary for our day and to acknowledge our sinfulness. We are to ask for forgiveness and forgive others and pray that we not be tempted. The Lord's Prayer tells us how to respond to God's love for us, as it also tells us how we should treat our neighbor.

The disciples and we are told to ask and to be persistent in our asking. Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

However, we, too, will be asked, and we must respond. No matter how inconvenient, the neighbor's need must be met. This teaching is absolute and demanding. It goes to the heart of our relationship to God and our neighbor.

SAFE PROGRAM
FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

1. **Screening** of staff / volunteers.
2. Adults trained in **safe environment strategies** and signs of abuse .
3. **Code of conduct** enforced.
4. **Open Communication** between parents and staff / staff and children / children and parents.
5. **Parents** always **Welcome**.
6. Children educated in **right relationships & what to do if a relationship isn't right**.
7. All children treated with **Dignity and Respect**.
8. **Clear Rules and Expectations**.
consistent reinforcement / consequences
9. **Adequate supervision of youth**.
team approach—accountability—no 1:1 isolation
10. All **abuse** is **reported**.
