How Good is the Lord!

What does the role of consequences play in our relationship with God? Take the lepers of today's Gospel. Lepers had a tough time of it in the time of Jesus. It wasn't just the effects of the disease; it was also the fact that lepers could infect other people. Society excluded them, they were forced to live separately and were not allowed to be readmitted until their healing had been confirmed.

When Jesus healed the lepers and told them to go and show themselves to a priest, he was encouraging the lepers to get the healing confirmed, so that they could re-enter society. Since re-entering society depended on being confirmed, there would be nothing to be confirmed without the healing. The consequence of healing was a resumption of participation in society.

When one leper returned to Jesus to give thanks for the healing without having had it confirmed, he was less concerned with the social consequences of his healing than the others. By not seeking confirmation, that leper was focused on something else: the desire to praise Christ.

By any measure, we have done pretty well when it comes to God's sharing His gifts with us. Our guilt on account of Original Sin has been removed, our nature has been elevated through grace, and our goal is the vision of God. We face the same choice the lepers did.

Do we thank God for the gifts we have received because of their consequences, or because we appreciate His loving goodness?


2025 Diocesan Ministries Appeal "Three Counties, One Family of Faith"


