The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed is one of the most consoling days of the Church's year. We celebrate our share in the Resurrection of Jesus as well as recognize our own sinfulness. Often, we place Christ and the saints on one side and poor sinners (ourselves) on the other. This is an artificial separation and distorts our faith.

When we pray for the Holy Souls, we are reunited with a broader understanding of the Church. The Church is one; not two separate churches, one of saints and one of sinners. The unifying bond is the love our Creator has for us. A bond that brings about the possibility to love God back.

In our minds, we separate life and death - past, present, and future. We think we can understand these realities if we think about them separately. If we want them to make sense, they need to be thought about together.

Death has a strange effect and is the hardest for us to examine. We are given this day to remind ourselves that our relatives and friends who have died, and those we never knew, were capable of sinning. We recognize this because we know it is true of ourselves. We want to be with God, but we continue to make mistakes. This doesn't lead us to despair because we believe that at death, life is changed, not ended.

The soul lives, awaits purification, and a share in the Resurrection. Our sure and certain hope.


Dear Parishioners,
