*It may seem strange that the celebration of the establishment of a church in Rome has a feast day. It is, after all, only a building. As Christians, we never say only a building.*

*Today's readings demonstrate how important a religious building is in our tradition. For the prophet, Ezekiel, writing from exile in Babylonia, the promise of a restoration for the people of Israel culminated in the vision of a new temple. A temple where the glory of the Lord would dwell once more.*

*By the time of Christ, Ezekiel's vision was fulfilled. The new Jerusalem temple was a wonder of the ancient world. It was a glorious building, which was a source of joy and pride for the Jewish people.*

*Christ tells us that even the temple, the highest achievement of the people of God, even the sacrificial system established by God Himself, are only stages on the way to something much greater.*

*Jesus expelled the sellers of pigeons and cattle and the moneychangers not because they were corrupt, but because that form of worship was no longer necessary. Jesus was present. He would teach them to worship in spirit and in truth.*

*It is no longer the temple in Jerusalem, destroyed in 70 AD, that represents God's presence among His people. Christ, Himself, is God's presence among His people. He is Emmanuel, God with us.*

*This doesn't make buildings unimportant. Every Catholic Church is the dwelling place of the risen Christ. Earth meets heaven.*




