The trouble with you is ... may be the beginning of a sentence we have heard once or twice in our lives. Usually, it is followed by very little, or no, practical advice on how we might improve. It's more in the nature of a hurtful complaint.

Not John, the Baptist. He not only tells people they need to improve, but he also tells them how they might do it.

The Gospels are unanimous that John the Baptist marks the end of one age and the beginning of another. The waiting is over *the kingdom is at hand*. After a long silence, John the Baptist appears as the last of the great prophets. The people of Israel had been without a prophet for too long, many believed. In John the Baptist, they could see an end to God's silence.

John lived in the desert, outside and away from cities and towns. It was fitting. It was in the desert that the people of Israel *first met* God. Their whole story, their growth as a nation, was influenced by God's actions in their desert wanderings which led them to the Promised Land. They were tested in the desert and when they failed God, they were told they would be taken back into the desert where God would again speak to their hearts.

John called for a change of heart and a way of life. He points to Jesus as the *WAY* to do that.
