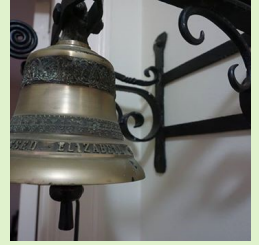

Did you know?

What is the doxology?



You've definitely heard the doxology, but you may not know its name. It's the phrase during the Liturgy of the Eucharist right before the Great Amen and the Our Father: "Through him, and with him, and in him; O God, almighty Father; in the unity of the Holy Spirit; all glory and honor is yours; for ever and ever." The people at this point respond with the Great Amen, either spoken or sung. A doxology is a phrase that is used to give glory and praise to God. When the priest says these words, he is giving glory to God in the unity of the Trinity, especially praising Him for the great gift of the Mass and the Eucharist.
