If you live or work in the Financial District, Seaport, Battery Park City or Tribeca, and would like to hang out with some like-minded Catholics, this is your place!


We typically meet up for Mass and brunch once a month, along with an after-work happy hour and other activities.



Jean-Marie Vianney, 1859; universally known as the "Cure of Ars"; compassionate spiritual counselor who spent usually no less than eleven hours every day in the confessional in the winter, sixteen in the summer; patron of priests and the parish clergy.

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD August 6



Transfigured in glory, the Son of Man has received kingship and dominion. He will come again in glory.

Celebrated by 5th c. East Syrians, this feast was inserted into the general calendar in 1457 by Pope Callistus III to celebrate the defeat, announced in Rome on 6 August, of the Turks at Belgrade. (6 August occurs forty days before the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, 14 September.)

DEDICATION OF THE BASILICA OF SAINT MARY MAJOR August 5



In the desert of Zin, water gushed forth for the children of Israel who tested the Lord though they had seen his works. You are Peter and upon this rock I will build my Church.

Following the declaration of Mary as *Ocotokoc*; (God-bearer) by the Council of Ephesus in 431, Pope Sixtus III erected in Romer this oldest basilica in the West dedicated to the Mother of God.
