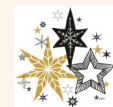

Last Tuesday, Dec 28, I suffered a serious seizure and fall outside St. Peter's church near the entrance to the parish center. As a result, I spent 48 hours in ICU at Bellevue Hospital. I have significant rib fractures, a fractured nose and other facial cuts and bruises. The good news is that I am already making significant recovery. However, I will be out of commission for a couple of weeks and will only be able to work remotely. My goal is to be able to celebrate Mass at Rosary on Sunday Jan 16.

We are blessed with Fr. Edwin, Maiwenn, Philomena and all our staff at St. Peter's who are more than capable of keeping our parish functioning at the high standard that you expect from your parish church. I thought that it was important to give you an accurate update as you know the way that rumors circulate. Already they include, inter alia, that: I was hit by a bus (actually a bus driver reported my fall to 911) or that I fell from the roof! (apparently I was lying face down on the sidewalk./street).

I am grateful for your prayers and support and I will
include you in my daily prayers too.

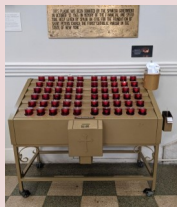

Sisters of Life GIVING TREE

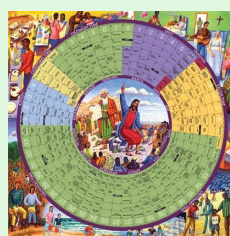
