**Saint Rita of Cascia, Religious
Monday, May 22nd**

Rita was born in 1381 in the town of Roccaporena in Umbria. She lived with a brutal husband and had two sons. After the violent murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day. Becoming an Augustinian nun, she spent some forty years in prayer, contemplation, and service to the sick and poor. Toward the end of her life, she received a wound from a thorn from the crown of thorns. She died in 1457. She is the patron saint of those in desperate situations.

May is traditionally dedicated in a special way to honoring and seeking the intercession of Mary as the Mother of God and Mother of the Church. "She is that woman who rejoiced in the presence of God, who treasured everything in her heart, and who let herself be pierced by the sword. 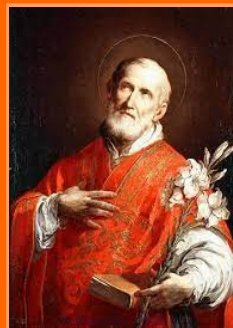

**Saint Mary Magdalene de'Pazzi
Thursday May 25th**

Mary Magdalene de'Pazzi, † 1607; Carmelite mystic of Florence who led a hidden life of prayer and self-denial, praying particularly for the renewal of the Church and encouraging her fellow sisters in holiness; instrumental in the reform of her Order.



**Saint Philip Neri, Priest
Friday, May 26**

Philip Neri, † 1595; founded (1575) the Congregation of Priests of the Oratory [C.O.], today numbering about 500 members, to promote holiness of priestly life and foster effective preaching; noted for his joyful and simple spirit, and his use of short, wise maxims; known as the "Apostle of Rome" and "Reformer of the Eternal City."
