

Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus Saturday, July 29

A pledge to obey the Lord is ratified by a sacrifice of praise. Jesus speaks of God's patience. In the household of Bethany, Jesus experienced the family spirit and friendship of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. Martha generously offered Jesus hospitality. Mary listened attentively to his words, and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of Jesus who humiliated death itself. Pope Francis added Sts. Mary and Lazarus to the Obligatory Memorial of St. Martha in 2021.



Saint Ignatius of Loyola, Priest Monday, July 31st

Ignatius, +1556; soldier, founded the *Compañia de Jesús;* approved by Pope Paul III in 1540; authored the *Spiritual Exercises;* founded the Roman College; at his death, the Society numbered 1,000 members in seventy-six houses in twelve provinces, including Brazil, Japan and India; today numbers some 15,300 members;

devoted *ad maiorem Dei gloriam*; patron saint of retreatants and soldiers.

Saint John Vianney, Priest Friday, August 4

Jean-Marie Vianney, +1859; universally known as the "Curé of Ars"; compassionate spiritual counselor who spent usually no less than eleven hours every day in the confessional in the winter, sixteen in the summer; patron of priests and the parish clergy

TWO STEP REGISTRATION:

Step#1 Online July 1st to September 30th.

Step#2 Mandatory in-person starting August 29 From 11am to 4pm

- First Communion

The preparation is a 2 year formation and usually starts in First grade.

- Faith Formation

The Religious Education continues in 3rd grade through 6th grade.

- Confirmation

The preparation is a 2 year program, typically in 7th and 8th grade.

Remedial program

This is a program for the children who have not attended the Religious Education Classes after their First Communion or have missed some years of Faith formation but wish to get confirmed. Fr. Edwin is in charge of guiding the children, 2h classes per week.
