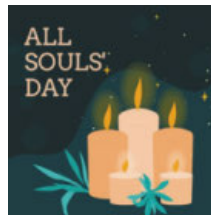

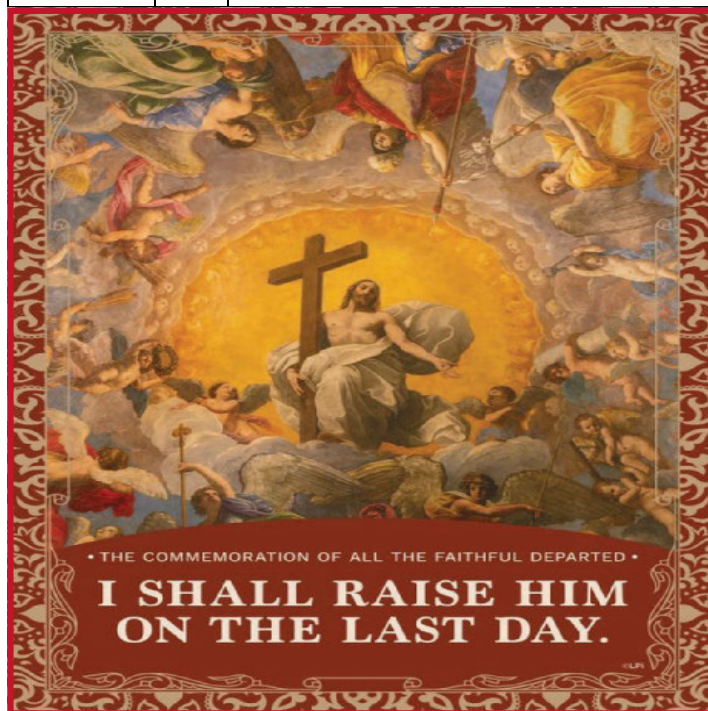

**St. Charles Borromeo  
November 4**

St. Charles Borromeo (1538 - 1584) is most known for living during the time of the Protestant Reformation and helped influence reform of the whole Church during the final years of the Council of Trent. Although St. Charles Borromeo belonged to nobility, he greatly desired to

serve the Church. In 1559, his uncle was elected Pope Pius IV. He made Charles cardinal-deacon and administrator of the Archdiocese of Milan. At the time, Charles was a simple student, but because of his intellectual qualities, he was assigned several important offices connected with the Vatican. After the death of his brother, he decided to become a priest and was ordained at age 25. Soon after he became bishop of Milan. Among his most important actions during his life, St. Charles Borromeo established seminaries, colleges, and communities for the education of candidates for holy orders. His emphasis on Catholic learning greatly increased the preparation of men for the priesthood and benefited their congregations. He died at the age of 46.

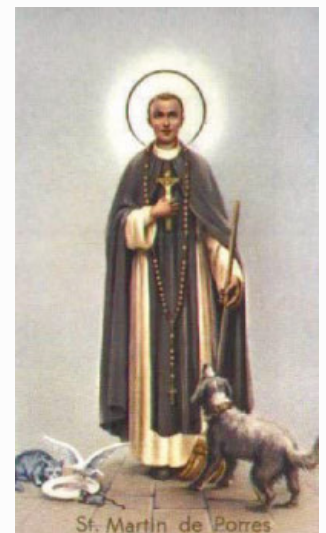

**St Martin de Pores  
November 3**

St Martin de Porres was born in Peru in 1579. His mother had been a slave, and his father left the family when Martin was very young. Even though he was poor, Martin was kind and always helped people who had less than him. As he grew up, Martin learned to cut hair and care for the sick. He



He later joined the Dominican Order, where he spent his life helping the poor, the sick, and anyone in need. He also helped animals and was known to be very gentle and loving. Martin worked hard, prayed a lot, and treated everyone equally—no matter their background or skin color. He started a school and home for children and gave money to help women get married or families to survive. St Martin died in 1639. Many people came to his funeral to honor him. Today, he is remembered as the patron saint of the sick and the poor.

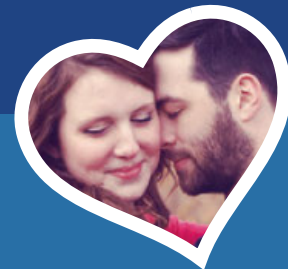

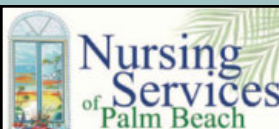

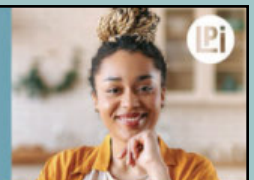
