

The Dedication of the **Basilicas** of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles November 18

The Dedication of the **Basilicas of Saints** Peter and Paul commemorates the building of two

Saint Paul Outside the Walls. Both were built in Rome during the reign of Emperor Constantine (4th century). These two basilicas serve a great importance for the universal Church since they were built on the burial sites of Sts. Peter and Paul. They serve as pilgrimage sites, allowing Catholics to travel to the heart of Christianity on earth: "ad limina apostolorum" or "[Go] to the tombs of the Apostles."

These two churches continue to draw millions of faithful pilgrims each year as well as many visitors from other faiths.

Dear friends in the Lord:

At this time of year, during the month of November, we come together to offer thanks to the Lord for the many blessings He has given us. It is also the occasion when we look to give something back to those who are poor. For more than 100 years, *Catholic Charities* has been serving all New Yorkers in need by making available a range of services that provide help and create hope for the most vulnerable among us, Catholics, and non-Catholics alike.

Beginning in 2017 with the centennial of Catholic Charities, I was pleased to inaugurate the Catholic Charities Campaign for Charity and Justice. Last year, it was renamed the Campaign for Help and Hope, a transformation of the Catholic Campaign for Human Development that better reflects what we do. Funds raised offer grants to parish and community groups to further the service mission of the Church here at home. Last year's collection totaled \$313,933. Awards are made to projects that are founded on the core Catholic belief in the dignity of each person, as made in the image of God, and try to advance Catholic Charities mission to build a more just and compassionate society. A key feature is that a significant portion of the funds raised will provide several grants to our parishes, in addition to community-based works of charity and justice across the archdiocese.

This offering is being collected on November 23, just a week after the *World Day of the Poor*, and the Sunday before Thanksgiving. The connection is so clear. Your support makes a real difference for people living in poverty across our archdiocese. It provides an opportunity to concretize Pope Leo's recent exhortation, "I Have Loved You" (Delexi Te), that the Church be a community that prioritizes the needs of the poor.

St. Cecilia, Virgin & Martyr November 22

According to a late century 5th - century legend, Cecilia was a noble Roman who, as a child, had vowed her virginity to God. When



she married against her will to the future saint Valerian, then a pagan, she told him that an angel of God wished her to remain a virgin. He promised to respect this wish if he were allowed to see the angel. She replied that he would if he were baptized. On his return from baptism he found Cecilia talking to the angel. She then converted his brother Tiburtius, who also saw the angel. Both men were martyred before she was. She distributed her possessions to the poor, which enraged the perfect Almachius, who ordered her to be burned. When the flames did not harm her, she was beheaded. She is a patron saint of music and of musicians.
