Pastor's Reflection

Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

I have Changed My Boyfriend!

A woman told the salesperson: "My boyfriend does not like the color of the dress that I purchased the other day." The salesperson allowed the customer to make an exchange, and the woman took a dress with a different color. After two days, the customer returned the second one and purchased the first one. The salesperson asked, "What happened? Has your boyfriend changed his mind?" "No", replied the lady, "I've changed my boyfriend!"

In the modern time, there are plenty of choices around us. The persuasion to choose one from the other is very compelling. The customers are confused. This confusion is made use of by the marketers to mislead the buyers. In today's first reading Joshua convened his people and said, "If it does not please you to serve the Lord, decide today whom you will serve, the Gods your fathers served beyond the River or the Gods of Amorites.... As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

Joshua, the leader, observed that his people were not consistent and committed to the Gods whom they chose; hence this request. He is encouraging them to choose the Lord who liberated them from the Egyptian slavery. In order to persuade his followers, Joshua is making use of the most effective commercial. It was the living example of his life and that of his clan. People were so convinced with his example that they exclaimed, "Therefore we also will serve the Lord, for he is our God."

As Christians our choice is very limited; we have to choose either the teachings of Jesus or the other teachings that lead us to eternal damnation. Jesus, having said that his flesh and blood are the real food for eternal life, observed that people began to desert him. Then he turned to Peter and his companions asking, "Do you also want to leave?" Peter answered, "Master, to whom shall we go?"

Let us repeat what Peter said. Also let us say after Joshua, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

Ruth A Gentile Woman

In the Genealogy of Jesus

The ancestry of Jesus consists of sinners and saints, rulers and ruled, priests and ordinary, chosen ones and gentiles. Ruth a gentile woman is one among them. (Mt. 1:5)

Ruth's story has all the elements of a romantic movie but it is down to earth, too. Elimelech and his wife Naomi, with their two sons, Mahlon and Chilion, who were Israelites, left Bethlehem their homeland for Moab a gentile region because of famine. Both sons married Moabite women but died without children. Elimelech also died: three widows in a foreign land. Naomi decided to go back to Bethlehem. On the request of the mother-in-law Orpah one of the daughters-in-law stayed back but Ruth insisted going with Naomi saying, . "...your people shall be my people, and your God my God: where you die, will I die, and there will I be buried: the Lord do so to me, and more also, if ought but death part you and me." (Ruth 1: 15-18) They returned to their flock empty handed having nothing to live on. Naomi was emotionally despondent too; but her family and friends accepted her with joy. Ruth started working in the field for survival.

Out of sympathy one land owner, Boaz, asked his workers to be kind to Ruth and leave plenty of grains for her and her mother-in-law. At that time he did not know who Ruth was. Later Boaz realized that he was a near family member of Elimelech, the husband of Naomi. This led Boaz to take Naomi and Ruth into his care. Having instructed by the mother-in-law Ruth asked Boaz to become the kinsman-redeemer for them. But there was another man in the village who had the right to be their kinsman. This man was not willing to take up his responsibility, and consequently Boaz took Ruth as his wife. They became the great-grandparents of King David.

Christ's genealogy as a family tree has its proximate origin in King David. Joseph, the earthly father of Jesus came from the House of David.

What makes Ruth great, though a gentile, is what she said to her widowed mother-in-law: "....your people shall be my people and your God my God..." This shows how committed and faithful she was to family values and tradition.




