

Pastor's Reflection

Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Pluck the Tabernacles Off!

O. Henry, a known American writer, tells the short story about a woman whose mother died when she was just a little girl. When her father came home from work, the lonely little girl would ask him to play with her. Instead of playing with the little one, she was sent to the street to play. This continued and by the time she grew up, she was used to the street and made her living there. When she died, St. Peter asked Jesus, "I suppose we send her to hell?" The Lord said, "No, she deserves heaven. But, go down to earth, look for the man who refused to play with her when she needed him, and send him to hell!"

We are born and brought up in a society. We are influenced by one another positively and negatively. From a spiritual and Christian perspective, a negative influence is called scandal which encourages us to sin. Scandal is one of the topics of today's gospel passage. Jesus' stand on scandal is uncompromising; he said, "If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off. . .." Of course, Jesus is exaggerating to emphasize the importance of avoiding the occasions of sin. Jesus is asking us to reflect on our lives to see if there is anything that leads us, as well as others, in the wrong direction. Remember that being a cause to someone's sin is equally serious as sinning.

There are many things around us that lead us to sin: TV, Internet, social media, alcohol, seductive way of dressing, etc. These things present sins glamorous, and gradually we think it is okay to sin. Eventually it becomes an addiction. Once Mother Teresa said: "We have a tabernacle to Jesus in the Church and a tabernacle (TV) to Satan in the home."

Which are the 'tabernacles' in our lives that may lead us and others to sin? We have to try our best, and pray to God that we will be able to pluck these 'tabernacles' off from our lives.

Rebekah

Wife of Isaac

When advanced in age Abraham instructed his trusted servant, and sent him to seek a wife for his son Isaac (Genesis 24:1-9). Since he didn't want Isaac to marry from Canaan he sent him to his own country and family to find a girl.

The servant went to the city of Nahor. He had ten camels bearing gifts for the woman and her family. He came to a well. Several young women were there drawing water.

How to choose the right girl? He prayed to God, "Now let it be that the young woman to whom I say, 'Please let down your pitcher that I may drink,' and she says, 'Drink, and I will also give your camels a drink' let her be the one You have appointed for Your servant Isaac." (Gen. 24: 12-14)

At the request one of the girls stepped forward, and offered him drink, and for the camels (Gen. 24:17-32). It was not a small job to offer drink for ten camels. In return he gave her a golden nose ring and two golden bracelets. He learned, she was one of Abraham's relatives. He felt, she was the one for Isaac. Then she ran home. Having heard about the servant and seen the gifts Laban her brother went to the well, and brought him home. Rebekah's family believed the servant's story, and also that the Lord's hand was in it. (Gen. 24:33-50) They consented to let Rebekah go to Canaan with him. He gave rich gifts to her and her family, too. They wanted Rebekah to stay at home for another ten days before leaving, but he wanted to return immediately. Rebekah obliged, too. They sent her with her nurse and maids. They traveled towards Isaac's home.

As Rebekah reached nearer Canaan she saw a man walking in the field. She got down from her camel. On learning that this man was her to be husband, she quickly veiled herself. She went to meet him. Eventually they got married. He loved her very much. Rebekah and Isaac had been married twenty years having no children. Finally at around forty she gave birth to twins: two sons, Esau and Jacob. Being hairy the first one was called Esau; the second Jacob meaning "supplanter". Jacob was Rebekah's favorite son. (Gen. 27:1-29) She wanted him to get the best of everything. Though Esau born first, Jacob with his mother's help, tricked his father Isaac and obtained the blessing for the first born for himself. This initiated rivalry in the family, and Rebekah sent Jacob away to her brother Laban, and she never saw him again. This rivalry continues unto this time.

She was buried in the cave of Machpelah in the field that Abraham had bought for Sarah's burial.


