“If you don’t believe in the Resurrection, you can go on living your life while perhaps admiring Jesus the man, appreciating his example and even putting into practice some of his teachings. At the same time, you can set aside those teachings that you disagree with or that make you uncomfortable... If you believe that Jesus rose from the dead, however, everything changes. In that case, you cannot set aside any of his teachings. Because a person who rises from the grave, who demonstrates his power over death and who has definitively proven his divine authority needs to be listened to. What that person says demands a response.... The message of Easter is, all at once, easy to understand, radical, subversive and life-changing. Easter means that nothing is impossible with God. Moreover, that life triumphs over death. Love triumphs over hatred. Hope triumphs over despair. And that suffering is not the last word...”




Zoo Volunteers

Financial Aid is Available



Feeling pinched? We all know that our school is a amazing value, priceless in the long run, but sometimes difficult to finance in the short run. The Archdiocese of Santa Fe offers limited financial aid to families with children in its Catholic schools, including Holy Ghost Catholic School. Aid is awarded based on financial need. To apply for financial aid for next school year, apply through FACTS. There are two ways for parents to access the FACTS website.

1. Go online to the FACTS website at, www.factstuitionaid.com and complete a FACTS Grant and Aid Application **no later than April 15, 2016.**
2. Families that currently use FACTS Tuition Management can access the FACTS application through their HGCS Sycamore account:
 - a. Go to “Featured” on the right side of the home screen
 - b. Click on “Links”
 - c. Click on the FACTS registration link. This link will prompt you to apply for Financial Aid.
 - If you have an existing FACTS account, please enter your existing username and password and click “Sign In”.
 - If you are a New FACTS User, please select “Create username & password”.
 - d. Click on Apply for Financial Aid link.
 - e. Fill out and submit your online application.
 - f. Submit all required supporting documents by uploading online or faxing to 866-315-9264. Customer Care Representatives are available to assist you at 866-441-4637.

Families who apply for school tuition assistance through FACTS will **automatically** be entered as applicants for the Maloof Scholarship. If you need further assistance, please do not hesitate to contact the HGCS office at 256-1563.

The deadline for applying for financial aid is April 15, 2016.
