The Catholic Church requires that all those who assume the responsibilities and obligations of sponsorship for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation faithfully practice the Catholic Faith and are exemplary in their conduct as members of the Roman Catholic Church (see Canons 872-4 and 893). Consequently, letters of approbation will be issued only to persons who are able to make the following affirmations and agreements (please initial each line that applies to you):

I realize that becoming a godparent/sponsor entails a great responsibility before God and the Church.
I promise to give support to and guide the person I am sponsoring by my prayers and, most especially, by my own Catholic example in daily life.
I am not bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared. (This means that if married, the marriage must be recognized as a valid marriage in the Catholic Church. Catholics who are either married only civilly or living together as husband & wife without the Sacrament of Marriage are in an invalid marriage and thus, by law, have a canonical penalty imposed upon them. The penalty is that the person may not participate in the full Sacramental Life of the Church. Specifically, they may not receive Holy Communion, nor act as godparents at Baptism or sponsors at Confirmation. Thus, if you are married outside of the Catholic Church, you do not meet the requirements for being admitted to the role of godparent/sponsor. Know that we want you to be restored to full communion; please talk with your parish priest. He can help you!)
