

1. Evangelization Mission Ministries

Purpose: This area of mission is constantly seeking new ways to reach out to others with the Message of God's Love. Evangelization is the primary goal of the Pastoral Council and has two major thrusts: 1) Spiritual renewal, by which those who profess faith in the Gospel are drawn to more clearly reflect that believe in their actions, relationships and lives; 2) outreach, whereby ways are sought to share the faith with others including Catholics who do not practice their faith and those who practice no faith.

- Parish participation in non-Catholic ministries to the poor in York (Crispus Attucks, LifePath Christian Ministries (formerly York Rescue Mission), etc.)
