Bishop Peter Christensen will be presiding over the installation of a replica of the Original Divine Mercy Image at St. Mary's Parish in Boise on April 11, Divine Mercy Sunday. Leading up to that special ceremony, Mr. di Silva has graciously agreed to conduct presentations in both the Magic Valley and the Treasure Valley in both Spanish and English (Mr. di Silva is bi-lingual).

This incredible opportunity is surely the work of the Holy Spirit - and all of the details have "fallen into place"! For the past eight years, Mr. di Silva -- officially an employee of the Diocese of Vilnius, whose entire apostolate is dedicated to spreading the Original Image of Divine Mercy -- has always led pilgrimages to Vilnius, Lithuania on Divine Mercy Sunday, but this year, because of the lingering affects of COVID-19, he has been unable to plan his usual pilgrimage. So, he is able to join us instead!

Daniel is the world's most renowned expert on the Divine Mercy Image and will share with us the message of Divine Mercy as given to St. Faustina Kowalska by our Lord in 1936. As an added "bonus," a first-class relic of St. Faustina will venerated at each of the presentations. Please don't miss this amazing opportunity! Allow yourself be immersed in our Lord's Divine Mercy and allow this image to penetrate your heart and bring peace and mercy to our communities and our churches here in the Diocese of Boise!
