FROM OUR PASTOR

Living in DC: Reflections on the March for Life

The Priesthood has brought me to many places. Before I moved to Ellendale, I was asked to complete a degree in Church law in Washington, DC. The mere mention of this city probably stirs-up many responses, especially during an election year! Today I simply offer my reflections on living in DC and participating in the March for Life.

Finding solitude and quiet in a big city is challenging. A benefit of living near Catholic University of America was the towering Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. This enormous church provided many quiet places to pray and unwind from the stress of academic life. The number of small chapels dedicated to the Blessed Mother is seemingly endless. However, during the annual March for Life, the basilica would be filled with constant streams of young people from all over the country. I recall the amazement on the faces of pilgrims from our own diocese, many of whom were on their first trip away from home.

Airport runs were expected. I was called upon to get the bishop, drop him off at his hotel, and other errands as needed. A comical experience revolves around one of the famous DC roundabouts. I had two bishops in the car; we drove around at least that many times before I found the correct street! The only comment I received was "I'm glad you're driving," and, "as long as we make it to the airport on time is all that matters." Very gracious passengers to a stressed-out driver! Another driving experience ended differently.

I attempted to visit the travelers from Holy Spirit Church in Fargo. The group

was staying across the river in Virginia. I hailed a cab and got in. After asking the driver if he would take a credit card, it was clear that he didn't want to go as far as I desired. So, after giving me the riot act for wanting to use a card, he let me out in the middle of the nightlife of Downtown DC. Luckily, I knew my way to the Metro station and went home. The next day, after the March, I drove myself to Virginia to spend time with the familiar faces from Fargo. It was beautiful to hear the students talk about their experiences. They were excited to be included in such a large crowd of people making a peaceful statement. Some were shocked by the violent opposition and the vulgarity of their actions. Others were shaken by the realistic images of abortion that were present alongside one of the streets. Although the cold weather was nothing compared to ND, it was evident that their lives were touched and even changed.

The March for Life is seldom televised on the major news outlets. When it is covered, the youthfulness, joy and warmth of the attendees is passed over. Such reporting would hardly be able to capture the happiness that is found in the dark and dreary metro stations days before the March as the large crowds begin to arrive. Bringing it all back home, think about how often our routines are interrupted, and how many challenges and trials we face. Finding peaceful moments and getting where we want to go are not always easy. Be comforted by the words of the prophet Jeremiah: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you... I appointed you a prophet to the nations" (Jer 1:5). Where and how is God calling you to stand up for the gift of human life? Fr. Asselin
