FROM OUR PASTOR

A few updates...

Dear Friends in Christ,

I wanted to provide a summary of the renovation projects at St. Helena's and St. Patrick's. It's been a while and here's the scoop (not the ice cream scoop from last week's article!)

St. Helena Renovation Projects

The work included the following items: removing asbestos tile from the church basement. Installing an interior drain system in the church basement. At the rectory: new garage, replaced windows, new flooring, kitchen updates, bathroom updates.

The goal for our Capital Campaign was \$176,000. Some excess costs were incurred because of the asbestos tile removal in the church basement. The total amount raised as of 9/04/20 is: \$134,209. We received \$13,420 from the Hommerding Incentive Fund at the Diocese of Fargo. Therefore, our total amount is currently at \$147,630.

Your support is still greatly appreciated! The updates made to our buildings are necessary and will serve us into the future.

St. Patrick Updates

The Parish Council voted to approve the project of installing a restroom at St. Patrick's church. The current sacristy will be remodeled into a handicapped accessible restroom. The Council explored options for a lift chair to be installed. The Council decided to remove that option from the plan. The old sacristy will be updated and remodeled for use again.

The water hook-up and sewage tank will be located on the north side of the building. We are taking the necessary steps to ensure the full usability of the restroom during all four seasons of the year.

Also included in this project: the tabernacle will be moved to the center of the sanctuary (below the crucifix). The estimated cost of this project is: \$27,000.

If you have any questions about the project, please contact Jim V. Glynn, any of the council members or Fr. Asselin.

Keeping up the physical buildings of our churches is demanding! Your prayers and monetary donations are greatly appreciated. It is important for us to think about the needs of the future generations who will encounter Christ and his graces in the sacraments in our Parishes. Once again, these projects wouldn't happen without your input, support and effort. Thank You!


