### FROM OUR PASTOR

#### Influential Persons (3 of 3)

Dear friends in Christ,

Gymnastics is an amazing sport. Balance, strength, and mental focus are on display. Our hearts are torn when the perfect routine is spoiled by a fall or a misstep. The dreams of a young athlete can slip away so quickly.

Mental gymnastics is a term we use to describe the process of resolving complicated situations. Sometimes this term has a negative connotation, sometimes it indicates something difficult. The challenges we face in the world require a similar balance, strength, and mental focus. We become weary trying to discern right from wrong, good from bad, and true from false. How is it possible to wrap my head around such things!

We must properly form our consciences. What does it mean to form our conscience? The Catechism states:

The education of the conscience is a lifelong task... Prudent education teaches virtue; it prevents or cures fear, selfishness and pride, resentment arising from guilt, and feelings of complacency, born of human weakness and faults. (1784).

In the formation of conscience, the Word of God is the light for our path, we must assimilate it in faith and prayer and put it into practice. We must also examine our

conscience before the Lord's Cross. We are assisted by the gifts of the Holy Spirit, aided by the witness or advice of others, and guided by the authoritative teaching of the Church (1785).


