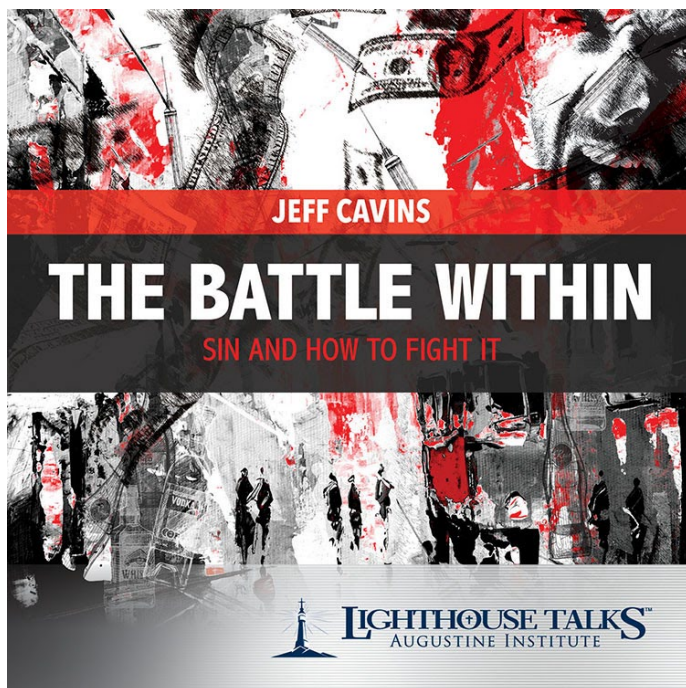
Mother Daughter Program

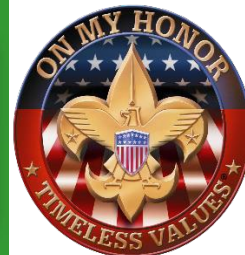
