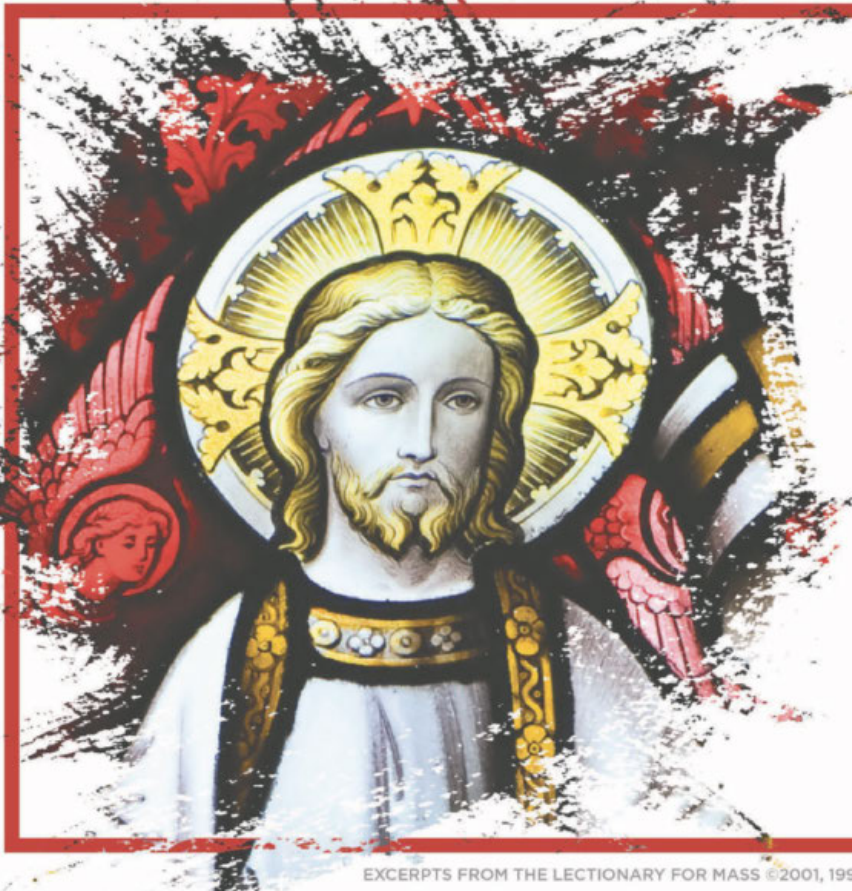

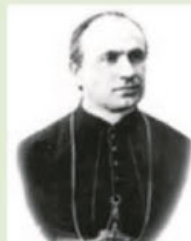

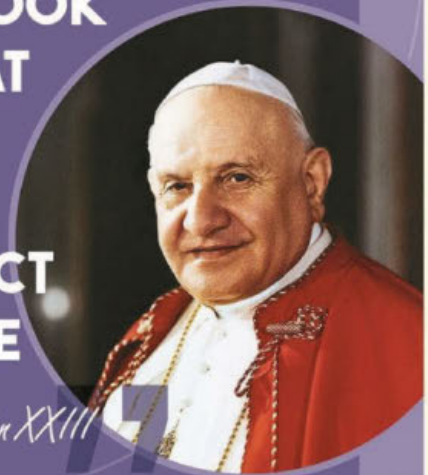

and lease his vineyard to other tenants." (Mt 21:41)

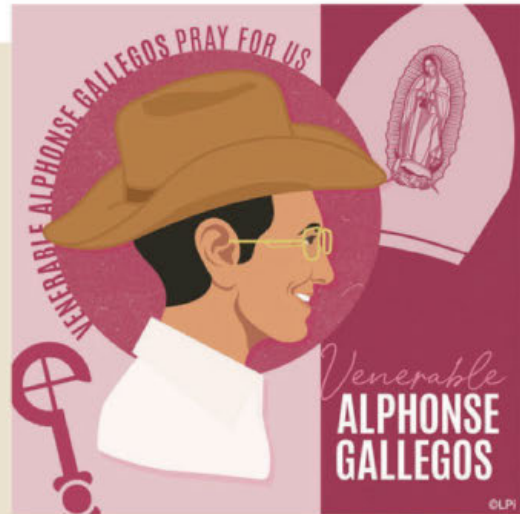
