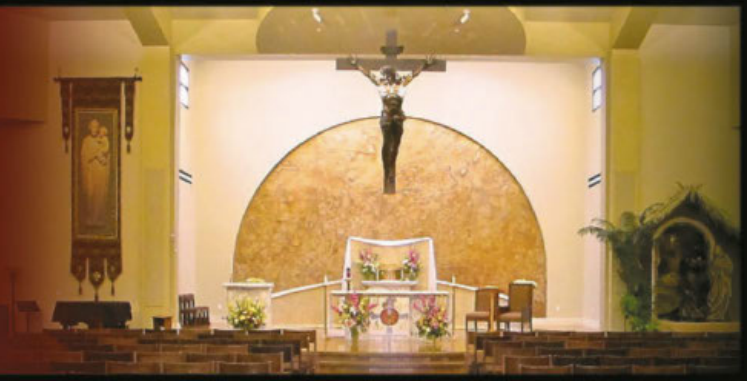

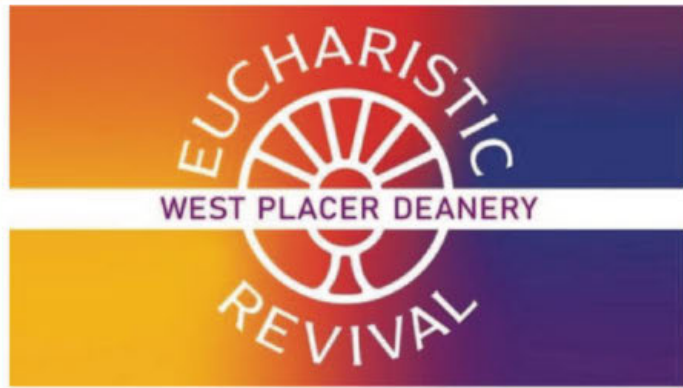
Saint of the week

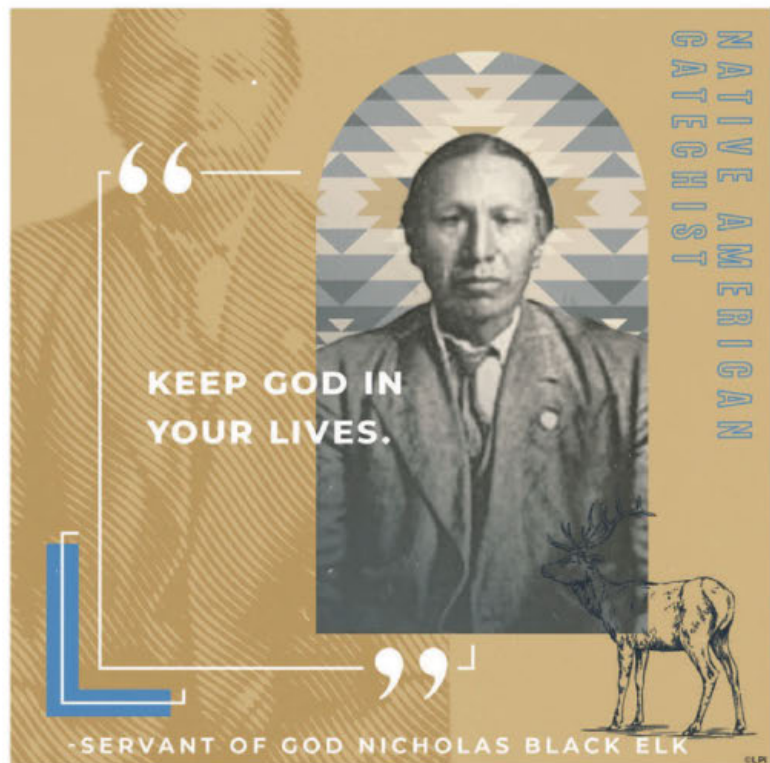
Gospel Reading
