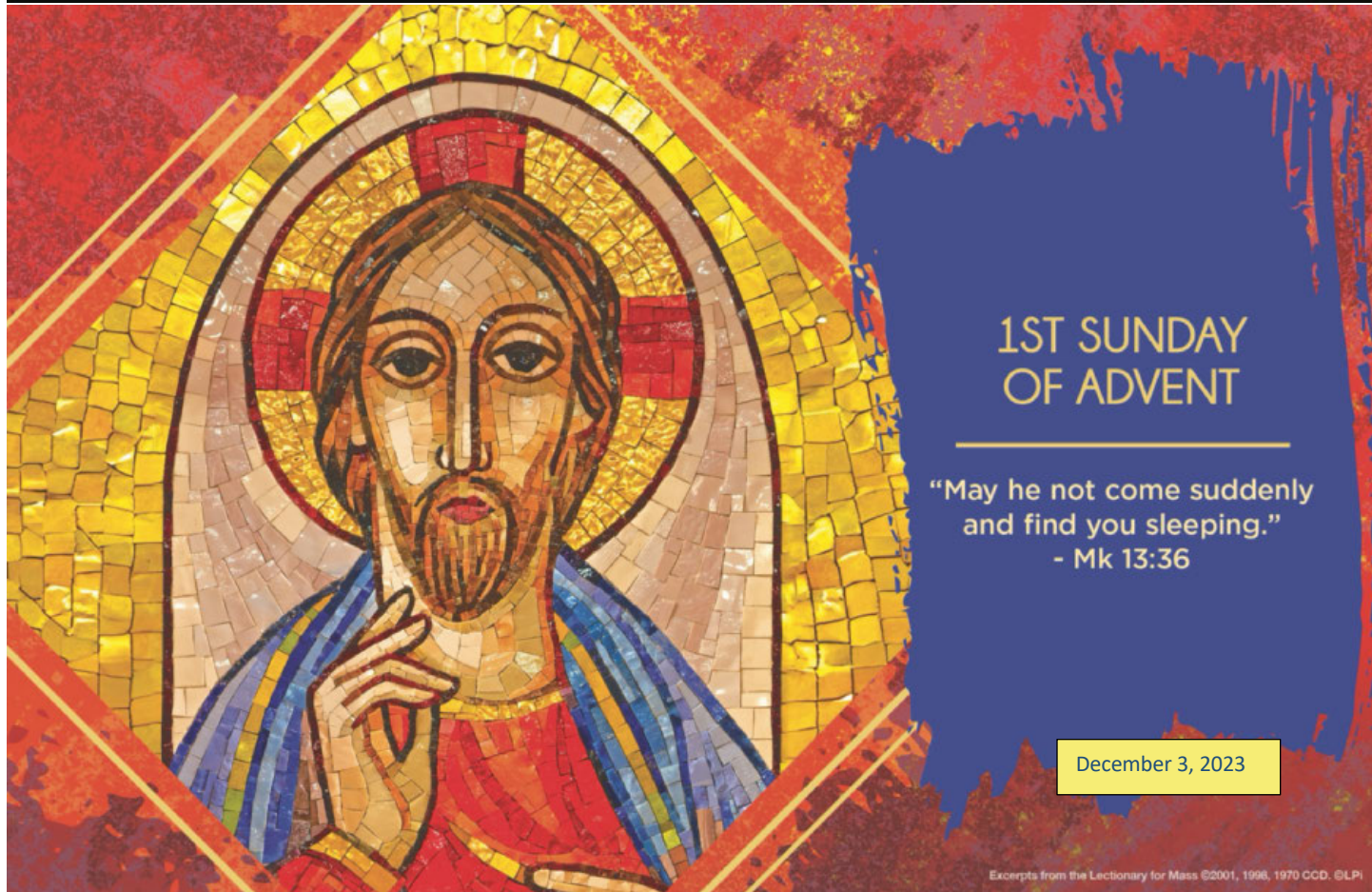

## Saint of the week

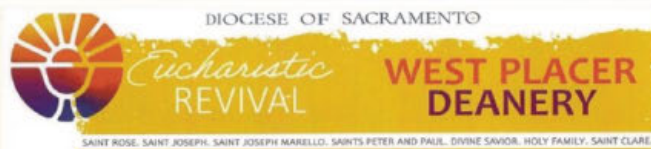
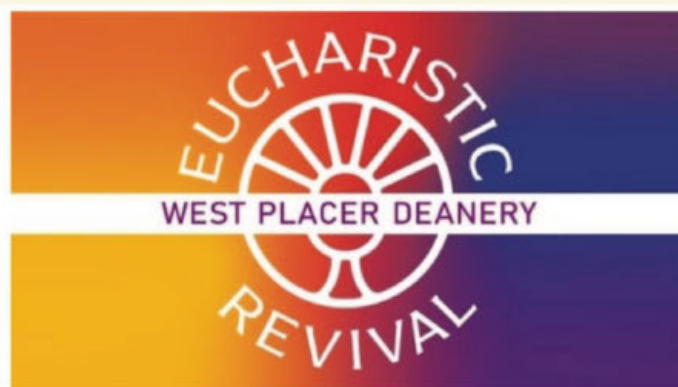
Servant of God Walter Ciszek was a Jesuit
