

Dear Parishioners,

Included with this week's bulletin is the *Annual Parish Financial Report*. This report to all of you is required by the Diocese of Sacramento and reflects our income, expenses, and key balances for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2023. It contains the same financial data provided to the diocese by our *Annual Financial Report* covering the same time period. This report has been reviewed and approved by the Parish Finance Council, and will be posted on the parish website.

This *Annual Financial Report* includes our annual budget projections for the new fiscal year, which began on July 1, 2023. These budget projections include detailed projections of anticipated parish income as well as planned expenditures.

I highlight some of the more significant items of financial interest which have occurred in our parish during the previous fiscal year:

- Sunday Offertory Collections did well and finished at 105% of budget and Donations & Unrestricted Gifts came in at 167% of budget. THANK YOU....
- Ordinary Operating Expense were held at 101% of budget and Ordinary Net Income finished at 118% of budget.
- Due to your ongoing support and generous contributions, the "Next-Step" fund contributions totaled \$136,480 and the fund now has \$671,785 to be used towards our next building project.

I thank you sincerely for your prayerful support and financial sacrifices you have made which enable us to build a strong community of faith in Granite Bay. We acknowledge that our real strength is our God. Let us unite in prayer each day that he will continue to bless us, unite us in ever stronger bonds of faith and love, and always be the guiding force behind any success we enjoy.

## St. Joseph Marello Parish Notes to the Annual Financial Report Actual Results FY 2022-23 and Budget Projections FY 2023-24

### **Ordinary Income**

- 1. Parish Ordinary Income increased to \$1,150,276 in FY2022-23, an increase of 5.7% over the prior year. We anticipate Ordinary Income increasing to \$1,157,500 in FY2023-24, an increase of .6% over FY2022-23.
- 2. Total Offertory Collections (our main source of financial income) increased to \$937,857 in FY2022-23, an increase of 4.8% over the prior year. The FY2023-24 Offertory Collections budget is \$951,000.
- 3. Religious Education decrease of \$1,640 in FY2023-24 anticipates no fundraising activities benefiting the World Youth Day parish pilgrims.

### **Ordinary Expense**

- 4. Parish Ordinary Expense increased to \$655,798 in FY2022-23, an increase of 17.8% over the prior year. We anticipate Ordinary Expense increasing to \$715,131 in FY2023-24, an increase of 9.0% over FY2022-23.
- 5. Parish salaries and related employee benefits increased to \$197,850 in FY2022-23, an increase of 41.2% over the prior year. In FY2023-24 planned increases in part-time staff positions and the related benefits require the most change in financial resources and are approximately \$39,000 more than FY2022-23.
- 6. The combined planned increase in Religious Education, Parish Programs and Other Expenditures total \$13,762 more than FY2022-23.
- 7. The Diocesan Assessment increase of \$7,793 in FY2023-24 relates to the increase in Offertory Collections in FY2022-23.

## **Net Ordinary Income**

8. Net Ordinary Income in FY2022-23 was \$494,478 a decrease of 6.9% over the prior year. Anticipated Net Ordinary Income in FY2023-24 is \$442,369 a decrease of 10.5% over FY2022-23.

#### Other Income/Expense

- 9. Other Income is expected to decrease to \$207,700 in FY2023-24. The FY2023-24 reduction in Bequests & Special Receipts relates to a one-time special receipt from the IRS for the Employee Retention Tax Credit.
- 10. Other Expense is expected to decrease to \$52,100 in FY2023-24 and is primarily due to a one-time equipment purchase in FY2022-23 that will not be repeated in FY2023-24.

#### **Net Income**

11. Net Income in FY2022-23 was \$684,272 a decrease of 13% over the prior year. Anticipated Net Income in FY2023-24 is \$597,969 a decrease of 12.6% over FY2022-23.







