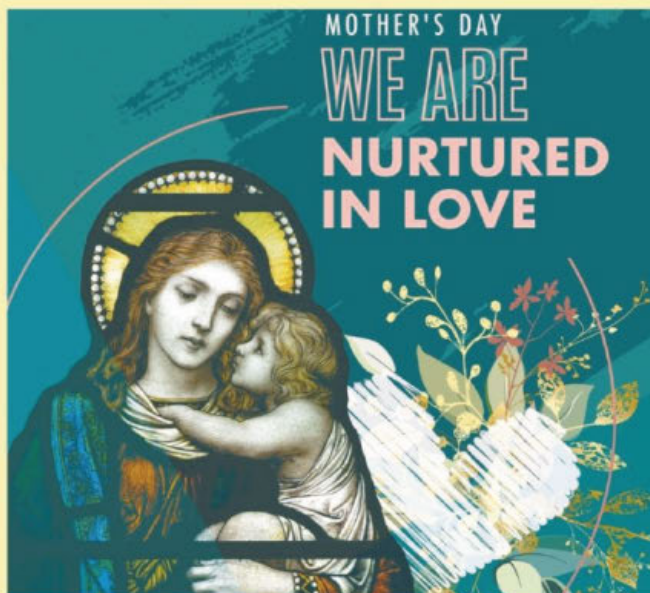
Volunteers Needed

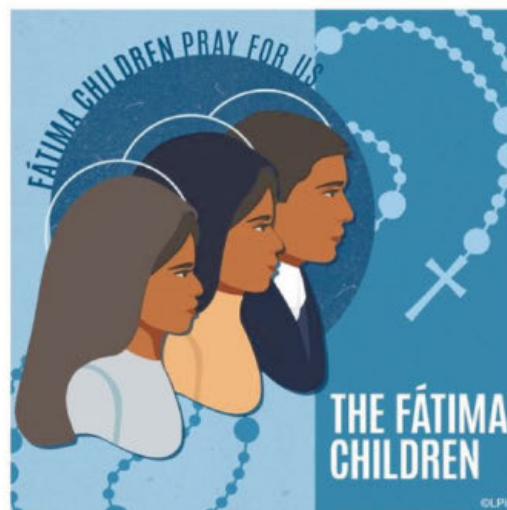

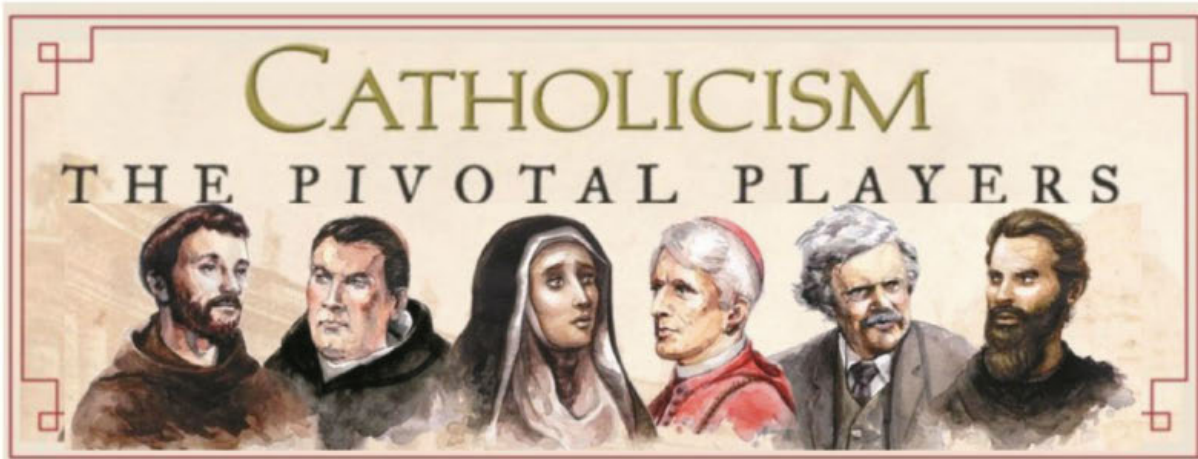
