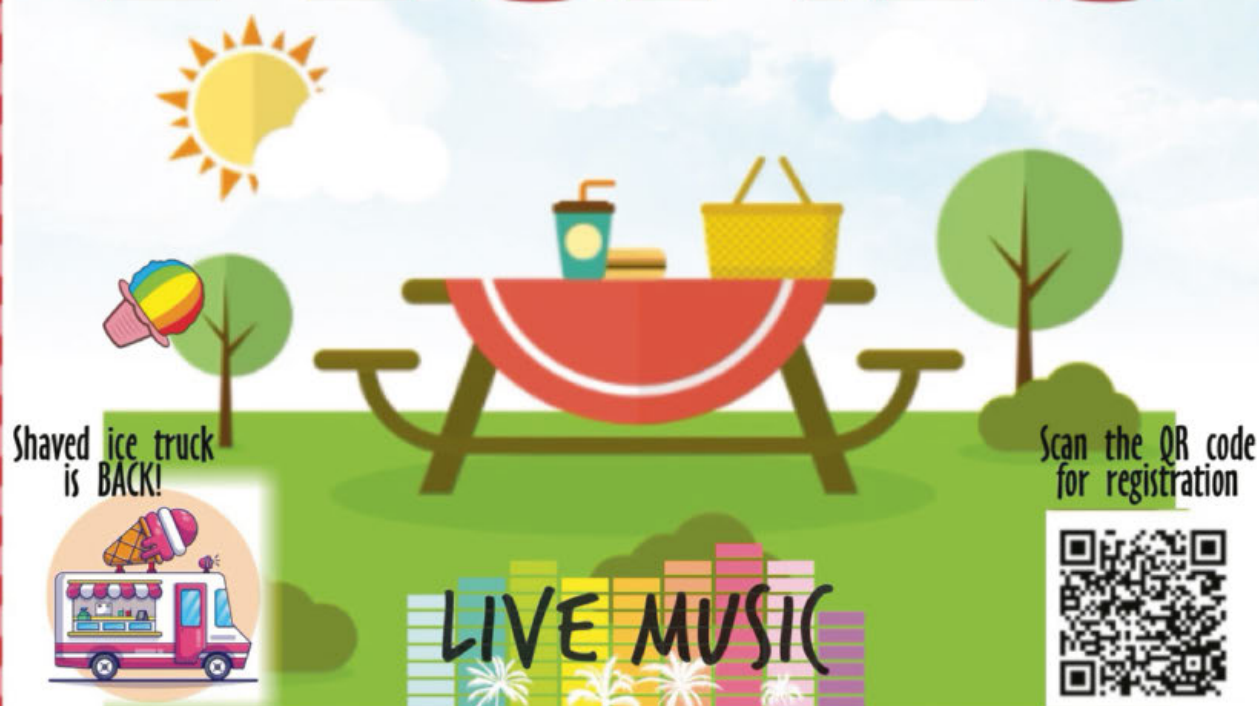

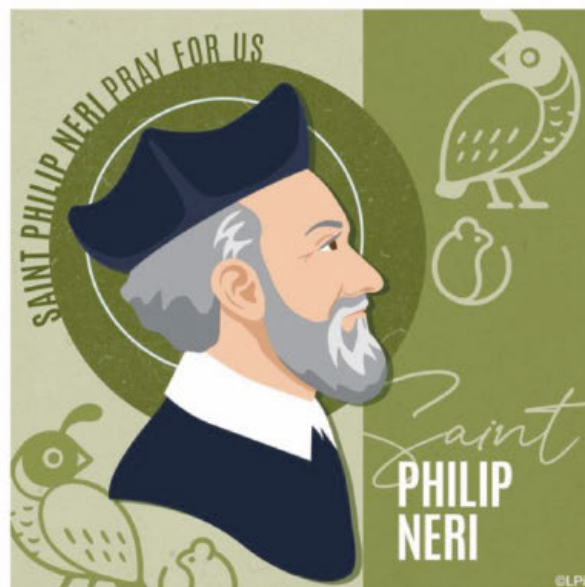

The Vocation Cross

Jesus calls each of us to build up His Church. In the parable of the Good Shepherd, he reminds us that “The harvest indeed is great, but the workers are few”, and He exhorts us to pray to Our Heavenly Father to send laborers into the harvest.

Jesus’ invitation is every bit as true today as it was when He sent His disciples to preach the Good News to whomever they met. We can respond to His call by praying to Our Heavenly Father for vocations to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, and dedicated religious life.

We invite every family in our Saint Joseph Marello community to join us in taking home the Vocation Cross for one week. You will find a signup sheet on the Vocation Table in the lobby of the church.

Complete the signup sheet by signing your name and phone number for the week you select. On the Saturday/Sunday of your selected week, take a Vocation Cross and prayer pamphlet home. Gather each day as a family and recite the Vocation prayer for that day. Return the Cross to the Vocation Table at the end of your prayer week. You may keep the pamphlet.

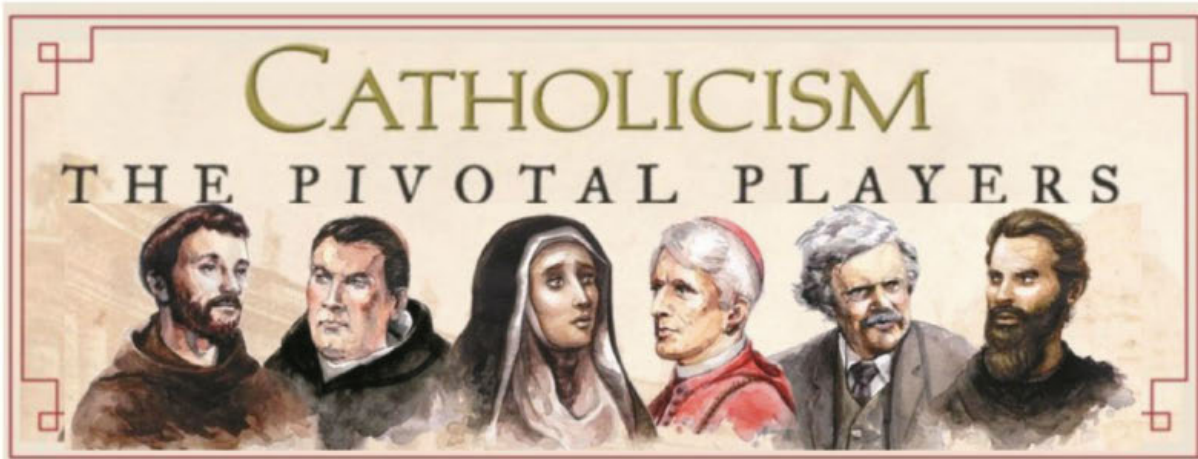
