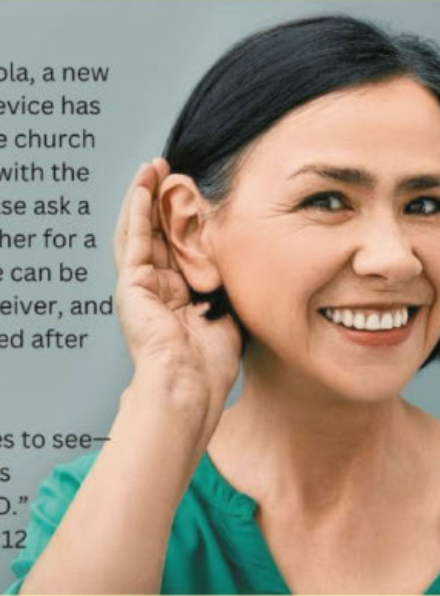
The St. Joseph Marelo Knights of Columbus will award a college



plants." (Mk 4:31-32)

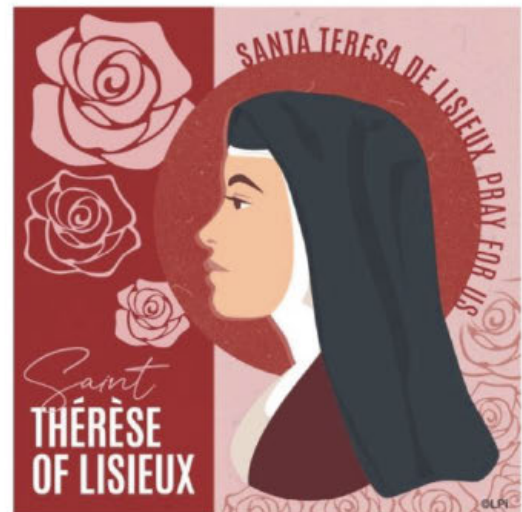

## Saint of the week

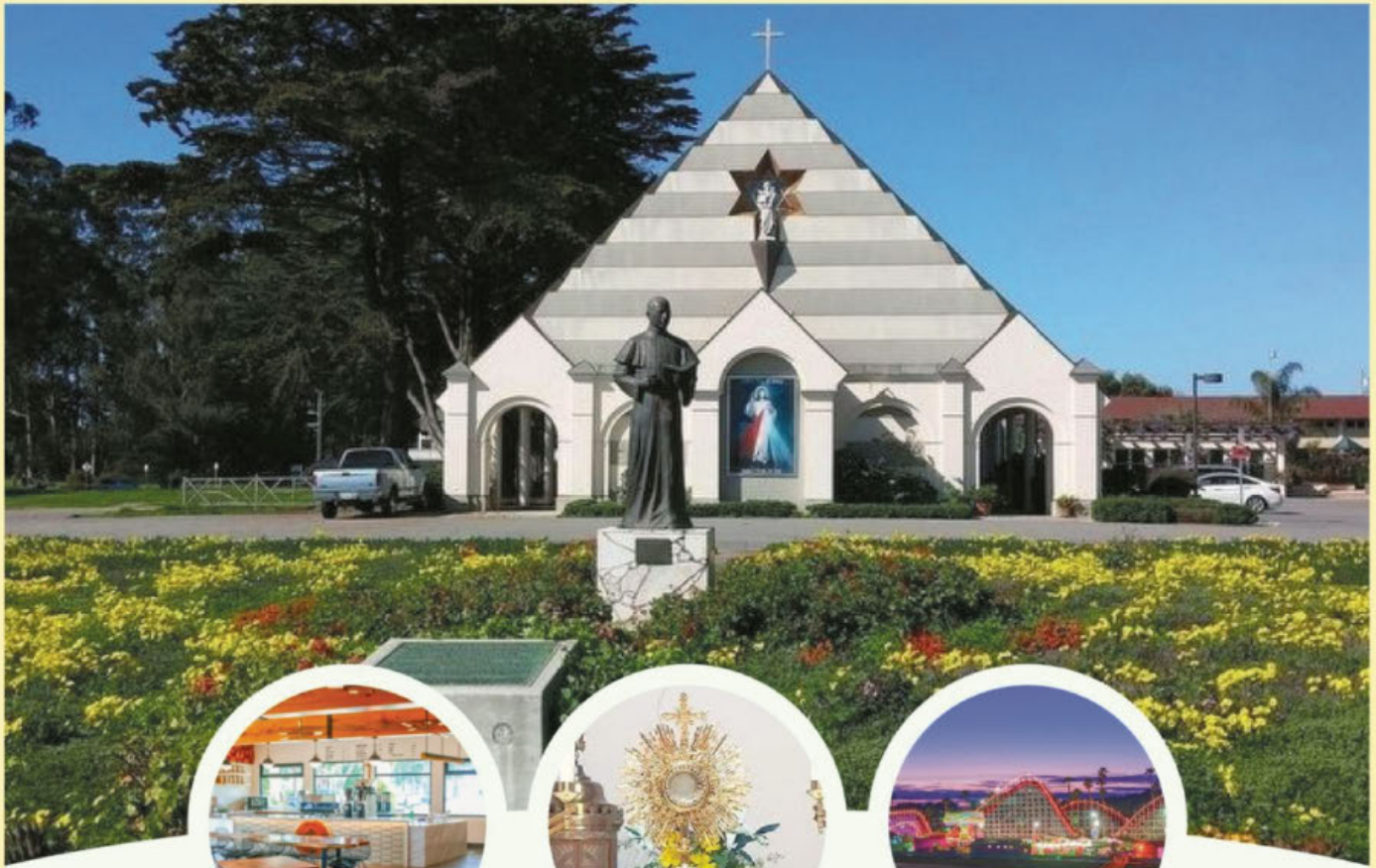
