

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.



At St. Joseph in Lincoln




Welcome, Fr. Brian - Finale!

After having spent my pastoral year at St. Mary's Parish in Sacramento, it was time to begin my four years of theological studies in preparation for my ordination to the priesthood. However, there was one hitch in the plan of returning to the DSPT in Berkeley...there was nobody else to be in the House of Studies with me! Ever since I began my formation back at Mt. St. Joseph in 1980, there had always been at least one other man with me in formation but none of them had continued and now there was one. Being alone in the house with only my director was not considered a good choice so it was necessary for me to go elsewhere.


The first thought was for me to go to do my studies in our Province in Mexico. It would be good for me both because I had been with some of the Mexican confreres during my novitiate and it would improve my knowledge and practice in the Spanish language. However, the Superior General informed my Provincial at that time, Fr. Arnold Ortiz (you all remember him, right?), that he wanted me to come to Rome and study with the other students at our International House of Studies (not IHOP but IHOS!). So, in August of 1988, I was sent to Rome and began my studies at the Dominican school there, the Angelicum, while residing at our IHOS. Though the original plan was for me to stay all four years, after the first two, there were now two young men who were ready to begin their philosophy studies at our house in Berkeley and so I was allowed to return (Hallelujah!) for my final two years back at the DSPT.

So it was that I was ordained a priest for the Oblates of St. Joseph on June 13, 1992, at St. Mary's Parish in Sacramento. It was a very special and blessed day and I am very thankful to God for calling me to such a wonderful and challenging vocation. Now it was time to start living that vocation to the full!


My first assignment as priest was to Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish in Bakersfield, CA, which had just been assigned to us, the OSJ, by the bishop of the Diocese of Fresno. I was there for a year and it was a great experience of parish life...and the only one I was to have on a regular basis until my assignment here at St. Joseph Marello in Granite Bay! This was because after this year, all of my other assignments were to internal positions in the Congregation: director of students at the House of Studies now moved from Berkeley to Oxnard (1993-96); vocation director and novice master at Mt. St. Joseph (1996-2003); Provincial of the California Province and Director of the Shrine of St. Joseph in Santa Cruz (2003-2006); General Councilor of the OSJ, Rome (2003-2018); and Vocation Director once again at Mt. St. Joseph (2020-present). During these years, of course, I would assist in our parishes but was not formally assigned to them...until now!


Ordination at the hands of Bishop Francis Quinn June 13, 1992




