Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.



From the Desk of Fr. Brian

ST JOSEPH MARELLO: DID YOU KNOW?

After the death of his second wife, Vincenzo Marello, St. Joseph Marello's father, tried to stay in the city of Turin with his two young boys. To this end, he enlisted the assistance of a sister of his first wife, Zia Caterina, of the Secco family. She willingly took care of the boys and would have adopted them if that had been the desire of their father. Since it was not and she desired to marry and begin her own family, she had to tell Vincenzo that she was not able to continue to care for them. What was Vincenzo to do?

A decision was sort of made for him when the last of the Secco daughters married and the house where he was living with the two boys was needed for the newlyweds. So, in 1852, four years of the death of his wife Anna Maria, Vincenzo moved back to his hometown of San Martino Tanaro with his two boys. This decision was also motivated by the fact that life in the city of Turin was not good for the health of the two boys while San Martino was out in the country with the fresh air found there. And, also, Zia Caterina, who had married, had also moved back there and would be able to continue assisting Vincenzo with the rearing of Giuseppe and Vittorio. In fact, looking back on his childhood years later, St. Joseph Marello would fondly refer to her as his "seconda mamma".

Thus it was that our Saint grew up in the small country town of San Martino, and not the big metropolis of Torino. His father had purchased a house and land with the resources he had saved up from his business in Torino. In the house were also Vincenzo's parents and his brother, along with the two boys. It was here that Giuseppe grew in "wisdom and grace before God and men" as the gospels say of Jesus. Truthfully, he was noted for his piety and goodness from the beginning. He did his elementary school studies from 1852-1856, under the tutelage of various priests who were the instructors at that time...which situation was to change dramatically in just a few years. But for now, Giuseppe was able to grow in knowledge in both religious and secular studies.

The pastor of the local Catholic Church was Mons. Giovanni Battista Torchio. He was well loved by our Giuseppe, who would continue a relationship with him such that Torchio was present at Marello's consecration as a bishop in 1889. He served Mass for his pastor and was instructed by him in preparation for both his first holy communion and his confirmation, both of which took place in 1855. There is a story told of one of the members of the local nobility, the Alfieri Family, noting with how much devotion Marello served Mass, such that he appeared to be an angel! He was asked by Mons. Torchio to assist with the catechetical instruction of the younger boys and was seen by his family and neighbors as a good candidate to become a priest. Was Giuseppe of the same mind? Find out in the next installment!


