Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

#### YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.



### Faith Sharing

Pope Francis-Declared this time a year of Eucharist Revival

In a recent book written by Bishop Robert Barron titled "This is My Body" he directs us toward the good, the true and the beautiful as Jesus' sacrifice of His body and blood is made within the Mass. But in his opening statement Bishop Barron says that a study in a Pew Research survey of Catholics states that only one third of Catholics believe Jesus is in the real presence of the Eucharist.

That being said, I just want to impart my own experience with Jesus' presence in the Eucharist. It seems to me what Jesus said about the sacrifice of His body and blood for us stands in the image of circle. It started with what Jesus said, "I'm the living bread come down from heaven" and it ends with Jesus offering himself at the Last Supper when He said, "Take and eat. This is my body." These words spoken complete the unity or beauty in the perfection of a circle. If you remove a segment of this circle, it becomes distorted. By not believing in His presence of body and blood in the Eucharist, faith in Jesus would not be all inclusive.

Again, Jesus states in John chapter 6 verse 51 "I'm the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh." For me His presence in the Eucharist has become more evident the more I spend time in Eucharist adoration. When I attend adoration, I try to spend at least 1 hour in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Usually at one point during this period I empty my thoughts of anything that would distract me from simply looking at Jesus and knowing He is looking back at me. So let me recommer this - if it's difficult for you to attend the First Friday adoration then maybe you could take the time after Mass to spend 15 minutes appreciating the gift that Jesus has just given you. -- Dave Cadden


