

Dear Parishioners,

Included with this week's bulletin is the *Annual Parish Financial Report*. This report to all of you is required by the Diocese of Sacramento and reflects our income, expenses, and key balances for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2024. It contains the same financial data provided to the diocese by our *Annual Financial Report* covering the same time period. This report has been reviewed and approved by the Parish Finance Council, and will be posted on the parish website.

This *Annual Financial Report* includes our annual budget projections for the new fiscal year, which began on July 1, 2024. These budget projections include detailed projections of anticipated parish income as well as planned expenditures.

I highlight some of the more significant items of financial interest which have occurred in our parish during the previous fiscal year:

- Sunday Offertory Collections did well and finished at 113% of budget THANK YOU....
- Ordinary Operating Expense were held at 103% of budget and Ordinary Net Income finished at 110% of budget.
- Due to your ongoing support and generous contributions, the "Next-Step" fund contributions totaled \$91,688 and the fund now has \$782,016 to be used towards our next building project.

I thank you sincerely for your prayerful support and financial sacrifices you have made which enable us to build a strong community of faith in Granite Bay. We acknowledge that our real strength is our God. Let us unite in prayer each day that he will continue to bless us, unite us in ever stronger bonds of faith and love, and always be the guiding force behind any success we enjoy.

St. Joseph Marello Parish Notes to the Annual Financial Report Actual Results FY 2023-24 and Budget Projections FY 2024-25

Ordinary Income

- 1. Parish Ordinary Income increased to \$1,226,179 in FY2023-24, an increase of 6.6% over the prior year. We anticipate Ordinary Income increasing to \$1,280,450 in FY2024-25, an increase of 4.4% over FY2023-24.
- 2. Total Offertory Collections (our main source of financial income) increased to \$1,070,192 in FY2023-24, an increase of 8.3% over the prior year. The FY2024-25 Offertory Collections budget is \$1,125,000.

Ordinary Expense

- 3. Parish Ordinary Expense increased to \$735,737 in FY2023-24, an increase of 12.2% over the prior year. We anticipate Ordinary Expense increasing to \$823,913 in FY2024-25, an increase of 12.0% over FY2023-24.
- 4. Parish salaries and related employee benefits increased to \$226,464 in FY2023-24, an increase of 14.5% over the prior year. In FY2024-25 planned increases in part-time staff wages and employee benefit costs require the most change in financial resources and are approximately \$45,000 more than FY2023-24.
- 5. The combined planned increase in Church Expense, Grounds Repair & Maintenance and Parish Programs total \$10,647 more than FY2023-24.
- 6. The Diocesan Assessment increase of \$23,821 in FY2024-25 relates to the increase in Offertory Collections in FY2023-24.

Net Ordinary Income

7. Net Ordinary Income in FY2023-24 was \$490,442 a decrease of .8% over the prior year. Anticipated Net Ordinary Income in FY2024-25 is \$456,537 a decrease of 6.9% over FY2023-

Other Income/Expense

- 8. Other Income is expected to increase to \$219,384 in FY2024-25. The FY2024-25 increase in Interest & Dividends income anticipates increases in savings account balances and interest rates.
- 9. Other Expense is expected to increase to \$115,400 in FY2024-25. The increases in Capital Expenditures is primarily due to improvements in church security and is contingent on the approval of grant funding.

Net Income

10. Net Income in FY2023-24 was \$616,675 a decrease of 9.9% over the prior year. Anticipated Net Income in FY2024-25 is \$560,521 a decrease of 9.1% over FY2023-24.
