My name is Maureen Spell and I volunteer for World Relief in Sacramento. World Relief is an agency that resettles refugees. All of my grandparents immigrated from Europe and settled in the area of Brooklyn, New York. Because of growing up in an immigrant community, I have always been interested in the needs of recent immigrants.

Currently, my volunteer work is to assist with resumes and interview prep for employment. I like the organization's ABC philosophy: A – any job, B – a better job, and C – a career job. You may remember that many Afghans who assisted our military were left behind and told to escape to other countries. Well, a new provision is allowing increased entry for those Afghans, and a portion of them are settling in the Sacramento area. Are you willing to help in this crisis by donating household items? World Relief can pick them up.








Homebound Parishioners
