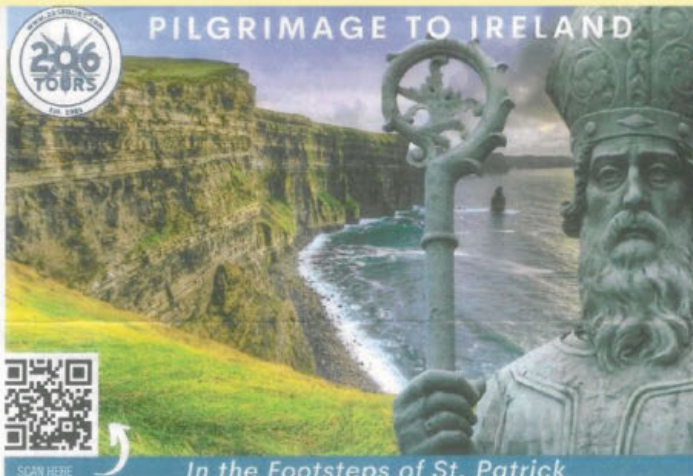

JUBILEE YEAR 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE

On May 9, 2024, Pope Francis announced the Jubilee Year 2025 with a papal bull called "Spes non confundit", which translates to "hope does not disappoint". The Jubilee Year will begin on Christmas Eve, 2024, when the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica opens, and end on December 28, 2025, when the Holy Doors of St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, and St. Paul's Outside the Walls close.

The Jubilee Year will conclude in Rome on January 6, 2026.

Join us in beginning SJM's celebration of the Jubilee Year by participating in our Parish Advent Mission on Monday and Tuesday, December 2 & 3.

Each day of the mission will begin at 6pm with Eucharistic Adoration. During the time of Adoration there will be the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Confession.

After benediction with the Blessed Sacrament at 6:45pm, a brief reflection will be given each night on the theme of the Jubilee, Pilgrims of Hope.

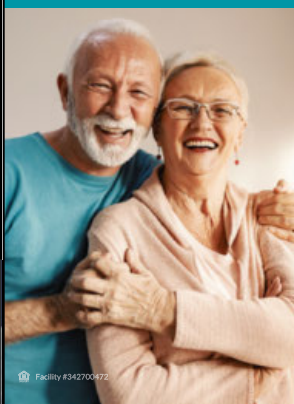
