From the Desk of Fr. Brian

Leading up to his ordination to the priesthood on September 19, 1868, St. Joseph Marello had been sharing with his ordination companions his excitement to finally be able to exercise is priesthood vocation among the People of God. Of course, he imagined this would be realized by activity in a parish. Bishop Savio, however, having noted the charisma, intelligence and, most of all, holiness of his newly ordained priest, wanted to keep him close and have him assist in the governance of the Diocese of Asti. So it was that he informed Marello that he would act as his secretary and one of his first duties would be to accompany him, the bishop, to the First Vatican Council which had just been convoked by Pope Pius IX. Certainly disappointed not to be able to minister in a parish, nevertheless, Joseph was very happy to be close to such a holy man and sure guide as Bishop Savio...and to be able to participate in such a great event for the Universal Church as the Vatican Council in Rome.

Before taking up his duties as secretary, he had the blessing of celebrating his first mass in his hometown of San Martino Tanaro. This mass was celebrated in the parish church along with his elderly pastor and mentor, Fr. John Baptist Torchio. It was a great joy for both of these men to celebrate together the mass. Marello had often served the mass for his pastor and now they were celebrating together! All of the Marello family, even those still in Turin, were present to celebrate along with the new priest. Both is father Vincent and his brother Victor were present and his brother later recalled that the people of the town were very impressed by Marello's solemn celebration and dignified manner. They all held high hopes for his future...as did God as we shall see!

His second mass he celebrated at a little Shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Mercy in the small town of Vallone, not far from San Martino. This chapel was on land owned by his Uncle Carlo who was husband to his Aunt Catherine, who had served as his "second mother" in Turin and San Martino after the death of his mother, Anna Maria. No doubt, it was also a great moment for Marello to express his great debt of gratitude to Our Lady for having come to him during his brief stay in Turin after leaving the seminary and directing him back to the same. She had also been instrumental in his having discerned the call to the priesthood at the age of 12 when he had made the pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Ransom in Savona. As we shall see, the intervention of Our Lady in the life of our saint was to come about once again and at a very dramatic and important moment. More on that later!

On October 21, 1868, Marello officially assumed his duties as the bishop's secretary. In a letter to his father shortly thereafter he shares that much of his time is taken up in tedious bureaucratic activities while also having time to write letters to his friends and for prayer. Most of all, he shares with both his father and his friend Rossetti, "...I realize that I am in a position with many difficulties and problems, but, what do you know, I am the happiest and most peaceful man on earth; when one lives with Bishop Savio it is impossible not to be happy and resigned to all things". Happy and content as the bishop's secretary, it was now time to gear up for the trip to Rome and the First Vatican Council.
