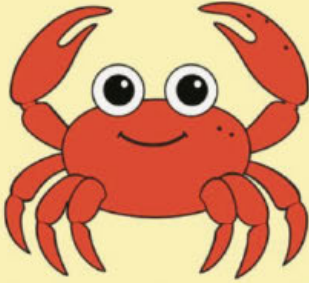

## St. Stephen Ministry

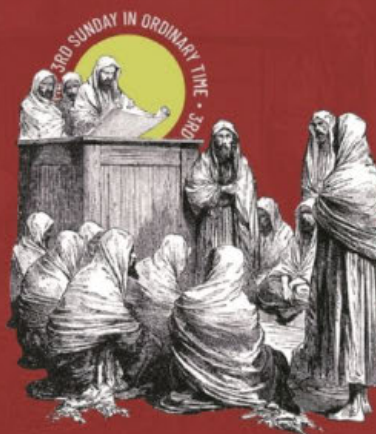

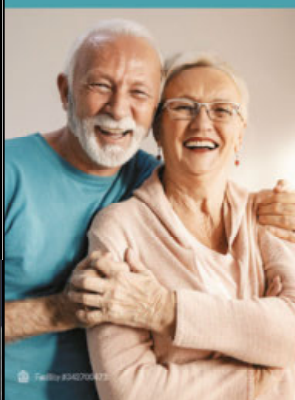
