








Gospel Meditation **Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

One of my favorite new singers/songwriters is Noah Kahan. I'm a little biased because, like me, he is originally from Vermont. In a fine song entitled "Stick Season," he sings of his hope to "cancel out the darkness I inherited from dad." This lyric articulates his painful recognition of a dark spiritual "inheritance" from his father, and his hope to be free of it. We all inherit some degree of evil from our earthly forebears. It's easy to feel doomed to repeat their darknesses.

But we're not so doomed, thank God. This week's Gospel proclaims this. Whatever good or bad we received from our parents, we have a more definitive and perfect inheritance in God. Jesus commands us, "Be merciful just as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). We have a perfect Father in heaven and are destined to inherit and reflect that perfect and merciful love. We have an inheritance of light, not darkness, and thus a whole new possibility of magnanimous love. Like any inheritance, this is a free gift to us.

What are we destined to repeat? Not the darkness of our earthly parents. We are destined to be a reflection of God's life. Jesus liberates us from the inevitability of repeating whatever evils and imperfections are in our familial or cultural upbringings. It's time to claim that perfect inheritance.





From the Desk of Fr. Brian

ST JOSEPH MARELLO: DID YOU KNOW?

Having returned to Asti after the sudden interruption of the First Vatican Council, Fr.

Joseph Marello settled into his duties as the bishop's secretary.

This meant accompanying the bishop in his visits to the various parishes and institutions of the diocese and seeing the needs of the same. These needs led him to propose, in 1872, the establishment of a "Company of St. Joseph". This company would consist of lay people voluntarily offering to "serve the interests of Jesus" in imitation of St. Joseph. These "interests" would essentially consist of whatever the bishop and the other pastors of the diocese, and particularly of the city of Asti, would point out as of most urgent. The laity of the company would follow the example of their patron by not seeking honors or recognition and working in silence and humility. The idea of the "Company" was presented by Fr. Marello to Canon John Baptist Cerrutti, who held several positions of authority in the diocese and was co-founder of the Michelerio Orphanage in Asti. The inspiration for the Company had come to Marello while participating in the Thursday Eucharistic Adoration held in the Jesus Chapel of the orphanage. The laity participating in the adoration time could be invited to be the first members of the Company as they were in a position to be the first to spend time with Jesus and learn of his "interests".

For whatever reason, Canon Cerrutti did not take up this initiative presented by the enthusiastic bishop's secretary and so nothing came of this idea. Perhaps a bit discouraged by this and by the death of his father Vincenzo the following year in 1873, Marello thought of becoming a monk, attracted by the prayer and silence of the monastic life. However, Bishop Savio, when presented with this idea by his secretary, dissuaded him from pursuing this desire and stated that he felt the Lord had something for Marello to accomplish in the world and not in the monastery. When after presenting his bishop with the same desire a second time and receiving the same response, Marello set aside this desire to retire to a monastery and opened himself up to whatever God would ask of him in the future.

He would not have to wait that long for God's will to be revealed and this will of God would combine both the idea of the "Company of St. Joseph" and the desire to enter the religious life of the monastery with the foundation of the Oblates of St. Joseph in March of 1878.
