Faith Sharing

On 2/28 through 3/01 I attended the Men's Retreat at Christ the King along with 6 other men from our parish. Those attending were DaveWhitman, Ron Kong, Chuck Foerster, Allen Cummings, Jerry Krebs and Jerry Prola. The Women's Retreat was held the week before and 27 women from our parish attended. The theme for the Men's retreat was creating the hope we seek and the sacredness of everyday life.

During the three days there were five presentations given by the Passionist priests along with Sister Kathryn and Talib Huff, a catechist. All the presentations were very beneficial leading us towards a deeper desire to hold fast to hope in Jesus Christ. Butthere was one part that struck me closest - an image of hope. It came from a short video by a photographer named Dewitt. The history of his pictures is of the natural world as it is common in everyday life. He describes the theme of his pictures as whatNational Geographic magazine called a "Celebration of what's right with the world." The pictures were common everyday examples of what is good in God's creation, be it of landscape or life images. Ashe went through a series of these pictures it became clear to me that our perception of the world controls our reality of the world. In other words, if we see beauty and positivity then we see good. If we don't see positivity but negativity then we see what is wrong and hope becomes diminished. But God is good and since our perception controls our reality, the more we believe in His goodness the more we see of Him within ourselves and in the divinity of His creation.

This example was just a small part of an incredible journey through hope guided by our speakers over a 3-day period. Next year I hope you will consider attending the retreat and finding your own way towards a clearervision and closer love for our Lord. For Jesus tells us "The Kingdom of God is at hand." --Dave Cadden
