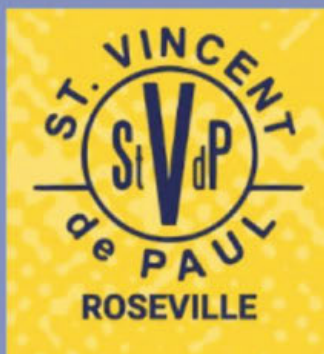



Devotions, *Explained!*

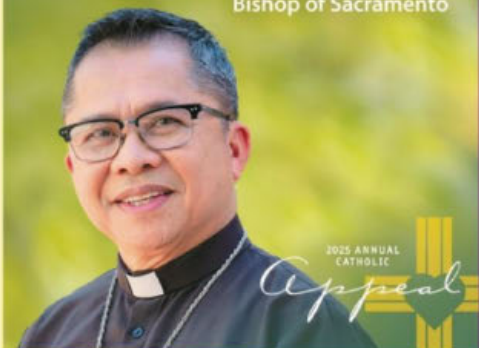

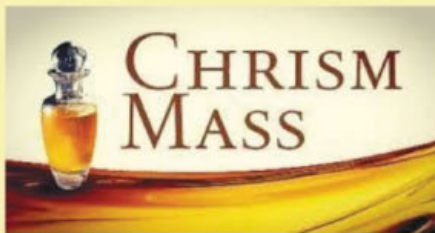

Name one thing you have done wrong. Jesus can forgive you for your mistakes. Try to forgive other people, too.

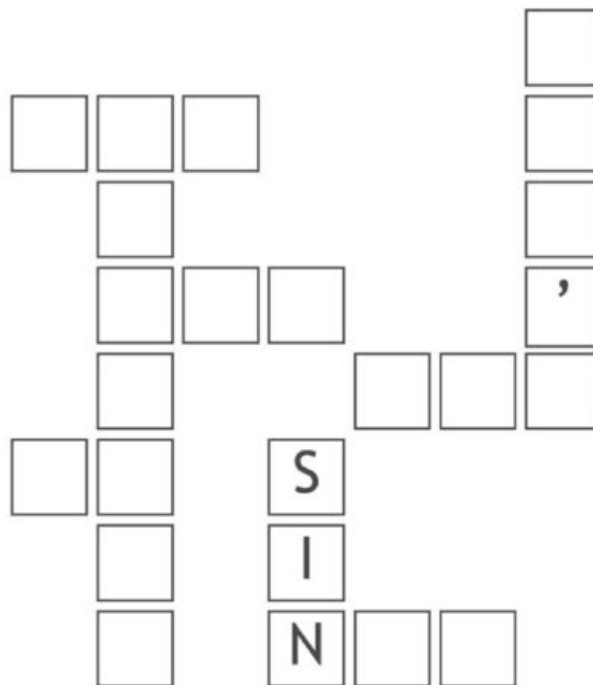
Sharing the Gospel

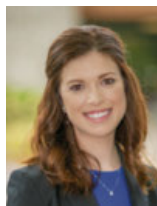
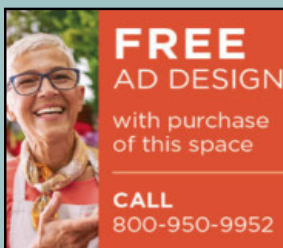
