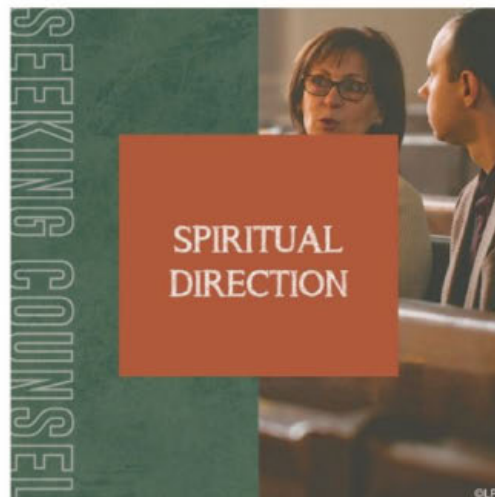

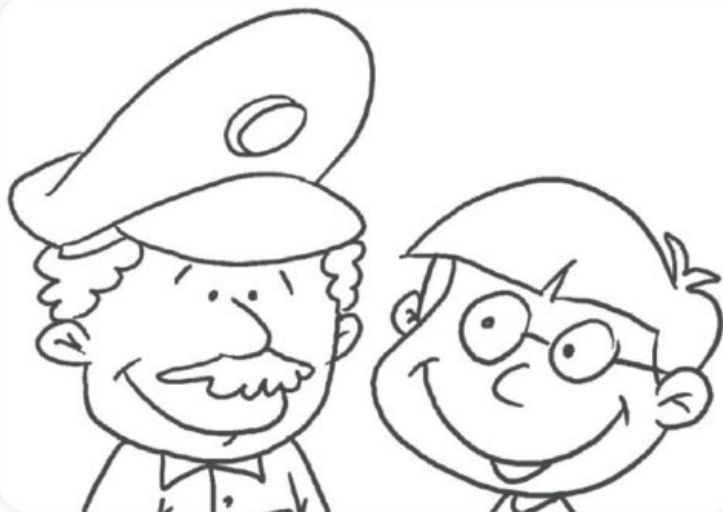
If you see someone who needs help, call 911 and explain who needs help and where.

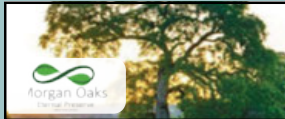

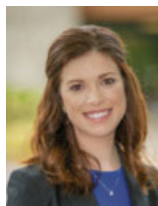
