# From the Desk of Fr. Brian

Greetings all! It has been quite a long time since I wrote about our patron St. Joseph Marello in the pages of the bulletin. Turns out there are quite a few things to do as pastor! Who knew? However, having once again found some time to write, I will start up where we left off. And, since many of you, no doubt, will not remember where that was, I will share the final paragraph of the last entry here and we can go from there. And away we go!

Alas, Marello's arrangement as confessor to his bishop, Msgr. Savio was only to last a year because in June of 1881, Bishop Savio fell seriously ill and died a few days later on July 1. With this passing, the Diocese of Asti lost a beloved bishop and the Oblates lost their great supportive "grandfather". Fr. Marello had lost his spiritual father and confessor. Now, what was to become of Fr. Marello and the Oblates with the arrival of the new bishop, Giuseppe Ronco?

Bishop Ronco turned out to be quite different than his predecessor, at least in his basic disposition. Bishop Savio had been a quiet and unassuming man, gentle and firm and very much beloved for his silent strength and learning. Bishop Ronco, on the other hand, was anything but silent and gentle! He was brusque and from a countryside parish. He was strong willed and had definite ideas how things were to proceed. However, he was a good and holy man who truly wanted the best for his new diocese and this was the most important thing.

Joseph Marello received the new bishop with respect and a little trepidation. When he presented himself to the bishop he also brought along a little written summary of the Oblates and their presence and ministry in the city and diocese. The bishop placed the summary on his desk. When asked a few days later if the bishop had any thoughts or comments about the OSJ, he told Marello that the document was still on the desk where he had left it and he was welcome to take it back. Yikes!

Canon Marello's response was classic, for him: he took the document and said nothing more to the bishop about his Oblate family. He put his trust in God's providence and in the bishop's good will toward the Diocese. Marello had been named the chancellor of the curia and so had risen in stature in the Diocesan hierarchy. In this way, Bishop Ronco was able to observe him and his manner. He is esteem for Marello grew and he eventually began to make use of the "brothers" as needed. So, the relationship between Ronco and Marello had started out rocky but the patience and goodness of our holy patron Marello soon won over the brusque and good heart of Bishop Ronco. The trust Marello had placed in his bishop was rewarded. Many years later when the Congregation was facing a very difficult future and the founder had already passed from this life, it was Bishop Ronco who took up her cause and fought for her continued existence. More on this later!


