


Come and See Weekend



From the Desk of Fr. Brian

Let us turn our attention to the situation of the Oblates in the Michelerio Orphanage in 1883. As you might recall, the Congregation had begun in this institute with the blessing of its director, Canon Cerrutti, who, in many ways, appreciated the presence of the brothers. They assisted him with the direction and care of the orphan boys and he was receiving a payment from Canon Marello for the use of the facilities. Marello was also happy that there was a place for his fledging Congregation but some problems had arisen.

Firstly, it was not always clear who was the one directing the brothers, at least to Canon Cerrutti! He had a certain tendency to order them about and not always with the knowledge of the Founder. This led some to believe that it was Cerrutti who had founded the Congregation. Disturbingly, one of those to believe this was the new bishop, Giuseppe Ronco! Marello knew that this would not be good for the brothers since there was tension between the bishop and Canon Cerrutti, who was seen by the bishop as a supporter of Canon Sossi whom the bishop considered a rival. How to remedy the situation without losing the place in the Michelerio? Marello knew he had to approach Canon Cerrutti, how he saw as a mentor, with care and delicacy.

This he did and the end result was for the brothers to occupy another section of the facility and for Marello to no longer pay for their use of the same. Instead, the brothers were to cook for (continued on next page)

Marello, continued - themselves (the money for the food being supplied by Marello!) and to provide for their own need while still assisting with the care of the orphan boys. Cerrutti realized that Marello was the one to direct the brothers and he no longer sought to order them about. This was fortunate because by this time the first priest of the Congregation was about to enter.

Canon Cerrutti had been opposed to having any but brothers and the founder had also been of this mind. But, once Giovanni Battista Cortona, recently ordained to the priesthood and a friend of the Founder, sought to become a member, Marello decided that God was also calling for Oblate priests along with Oblate brothers. So, it was that in August of 1883, Cortona became the first Oblate of St. Joseph priest and Marello allowed the brothers who felt called to do so, to pursue studies for the priesthood...and a new chapter of the OSI had begun!

But, what would be the reaction of Bishop Ronco to this development? After all, he would be the one who would be asked to ordain these men when the time came. Would he support the Congregation? Would he allow Marello to continue this adventure of love? Well, clearly he would since the OSJ are still around...we shall see exactly what took place so that this would happen.
