

We have listed some suggestions below, but feel free to include whatever your family enjoys having during the Thanksgiving holiday. COMPLETE DINNERS ARE GIVEN TO THE FAMILIES/ORGANIZATIONS. PLEASE PUT YOUR COMPLETE DINNER IN ONE CONTAINER. We ask you not to use separate shopping bags as items could become separated and not seen as a complete basket.

- Disposable aluminum roasting pan
- Can opener
- A frozen turkey (DO NOT DEFROST TURKEY)
- Boxed or bagged stuffing (such as Stove Top)
- Cans of candied yams or white potatoes or box of instant mashed potatoes
- Boxed or bagged pasta
- Boxed or bagged rice
- Cans of beans
- Cans or jars of cranberry sauce
- Cans of vegetables

- Cans or jars of applesauce
- Cans or jars of gravy
- Boxed brownie mix or cake mix or cookies
- Boxes of Jello or pudding
- Pies (already cooked, not frozen)


