



Saint Joseph

Husband of Mary; Guardian of Jesus; The Worker; Protector of the Church

That resumé alone would put anyone at the top of the list of most important people. But it has taken Pope Francis' dedication of the year 2021 as the "Year of Saint Joseph" to put his influence into focus. Perhaps it's Saint Joseph's humility that keeps his crucial role in the background.

Saint Joseph appears only at the beginning of the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. No words of his are quoted, but we can see from his actions that he was a man totally devoted to the Lord. Joseph took Mary into his home as his wife, even after the discovery of her pregnancy. He accepted Jesus as his own child and provided for Him and taught Him the family business of carpentry. In one incident, Joseph and Mary frantically search for their Son in a crowded Jerusalem during the time of the feast. We presume that Joseph died a peaceful death sometime while Jesus was still living at home.

May we honor Saint Joseph as a great model of faithfulness. We can meditate on those details that we have of him, and come to imagine his other inspiring qualities and virtues.

Kid's Questions - If Jesus Came Back

To Life. Where Is He Now?

After Jesus rose from the dead, He spent 40 days on earth teaching and visiting with His followers: After 40 days, He ascended into heaven. This means Jesus' body and soul; reunited when He rose from the dead, went up into heaven as one. This event was part of God's plan to show us the power of God and the eternal rewards we can share if we live our lives for Christ.

Before Jesus rose into heaven, he instructed the disciples to pray and wait. Nine days after the Ascension, the Holy Spirit was sent down at Pentecost. Even though Jesus left the world, He sent us help to live as Catholic Christians in the form of the Holy Spirit.

3 Places to Find Jesus Today

- Jesus is all around us. He's in your neighbor, in the poor, in your friends, in your family and in you! As Christians we are called to always treat others as Jesus, and to represent Jesus back to them.
- Jesus is also present in the Eucharist. At Mass, we take Jesus into our bodies so that He can strengthen us. We are so close to heaven when we participate in the Eucharist!
- Jesus is in all of creation. The earth and all its creatures were created by God. We are entrusted with caring for it so that people can see God in the beauty that is creation.

Fourth Sunday of Easter April 25, 2021

"Leaders of the people and elders: if we are being examined today about a good deed being done to a cripple, namely, by what means he was saved, then all of you and all the people of Israel should know that it was in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, in his name this man stands before you healed... there is no salvation through anyone else."

The clear and forceful sermons of Peter in the Acts of the Apostles provide the foundation of our faith in Jesus Christ. The same apostle who denied knowing Christ, bravely addressed those who were against or challenged the mighty deeds of the Lord.
