

# The Challenge of Living the Beatitudes

"Blessed are you who are poor"

-- Luke 6: 20



Who actually wants to embrace a life of poverty, mourning and hunger? Who actually believes that poverty is the way to blessing and happiness? Jesus does, because that's the way He lived, and it's the way He wants all of us to live as well.

Deep down, we all know that money doesn't make people happy. There are plenty of miserable millionaires. Rich or poor, it is good relationships that make people happy. And what could be a more important relationship that our relationship with God? No wonder Jesus was so happy. He had an unbroken relationship with His heavenly Father.

Jesus didn't restrict His vision to the world around Him. He also kept His eyes fixed on His heavenly Father. With His heart lifted up to God's presence, and His mind filled with truth by the Holy Spirit, Jesus was able to look at life clearly and joyfully. He wasn't bound by money or the desire for a problem-free life where He always got His way. He was happy just knowing His Father, and following His Father's Will.

Jesus gave us the Beatitudes to teach us the secret of happiness. He knows that prosperous sinners are miserable people—however much the world envies them. The world cannot see the emotions of a heart that is devoid of God's love. It's important to know that Jesus is not against money itself. He only wants us to set goals that go far beyond the accumulation of wealth.

Jesus once told His disciples that He had 'food' that they knew nothing about, and that this 'food' was to do His Father's Will (John 4: 32, 34). As we learn to keep our minds fixed on the promises of God, we too will discover the secret to Jesus' peace and happiness. By following in Jesus' footsteps, we can know the same happiness He knew—the same happiness that fills all the saints and angels in heaven.

#### The Beatitudes

In today's Gospel, we heard Jesus speaking to His followers about how to live a happy and holy life. When Jesus was teaching the people in His Sermon on the Mount, He gave them and us the Beatitudes:

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted. Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land. Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

The Beatitudes are some of the most familiar teachings of Jesus, and also some of the most challenging. In a 2011 Angelus address, Pope Benedict XVI called the Beatitudes a "new program of life" that "free ourselves from the false values of the world and open ourselves to the true good, present and future."





"Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose hope is the Lord. He is like a tree planted beside the water that stretches out its roots in the stream. It fears not the heat when it comes, its leaves stay green; in the year of drought it shows no distress, but still bears fruit."

May we listen as Jeremiah speaks and using the image from the environment, reflect upon his teaching. Where do I place my trust, in whom is my hope?

As we experience climate change, reflect upon Francis' Laudato Si', as we watch millions of acres burn, floods wipe out entire villages, and crops spoil because of lack of rain, Jeremiah's words should touch us deeply. The earth and what it contains is a gift and we are to take care of it for present and future generations.
