

# **Trom the Pastor's Desk...**

This week and the following week, I will be away from the parish. Part of that time will be spent visiting family and friends. Also, I will be heading to St. Louis for the annual American Catholic Philosophical Association Conference. We will not be having daily Masses or our regularly scheduled Holy Hours during that time. Fr. Thomas Blau, OP will be coming to celebrate Saturday and Sunday Masses on the 20th and 21st respectively. I will be back to celebrate Mass for Thanksgiving and the following Friday.

Please, remember that we are getting close to the Advent season. So, we can give some thought as to how we are going to make this Advent a true time of preparation for the coming of the Christ Child. Will we say a specific prayer every day? Will we read from the Gospels, the Psalms, the Book of Isaiah, or some other Scripture? Will we put aside some time to volunteer for the needy? Will we fast from some convenience or luxury and use the money normally spend on it for those in need? Will we take time away from television, social media, or other entertainment and use it to do some spiritual reading in preparation for the coming of Our Lord?
