



Feast of the Presentation: Blessing of Candles

Friday, February 2

Before 6:30 AM and 9 AM Masses

The traditional blessing for candles will be offered on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. If you would like to have candles blessed for devotional use, please bring them for the blessing before Masses on February 2.

The Feast of the Presentation has been celebrated with the blessing of candles and a candlelight procession for many centuries, and is sometimes referred to as "Candlemas." On this feast, we read the words of Simeon, who recognized the infant Christ as the "Light for revelation."

"Our lighted candles are a sign of the divine splendor of the one who comes to expel the dark shadows of evil and to make the whole universe radiant with the brilliance of his eternal light. Our candles also show how bright our souls should be when we go to meet Christ...

The true light has come, the light that enlightens every man who is born into this world. Let all of us, my brethren, be enlightened and made radiant by this light. Let all of us share in its splendor, and be so filled with it that no one remains in the darkness. Let us be shining ourselves as we go together to meet and to receive with the aged Simeon the light whose brilliance is eternal" (St. Sophronius).

The customary St. Blaise Blessing of Throats will be offered at St. Philip's.

Who was St. Blaise? Ancient martyrologies describe St. Blaise as a fourth century bishop and martyr of Sebaste in Armenia. A famous story about St. Blaise relates that he saved a boy from choking to death on a fishbone; this, or the story that St. Blaise was a physician, may be the reason St. Blaise is traditionally invoked by those suffering from throat illness.







Located at the northeast corner of our campus, Phase I of the St. Philip Columbarium was completed with the 2022 relocation of the parish to Flower Mound. Plans are now in progress to expand the Columbarium and presale is available for niches in the next Phase of construction. The planned expansion will add another wing including 270 new niches to our existing Columbarium, extending the walls to make a more enclosed and prayerful space. New landscaping and architectural elements will create a peaceful surrounding for visitors to the area, and the extended pavement will allow more families to conveniently attend interments. Construction of the Columbarium expansion will begin after the sale of the first 175 niches, and in conjunction with initiation of the planned parish life center.




