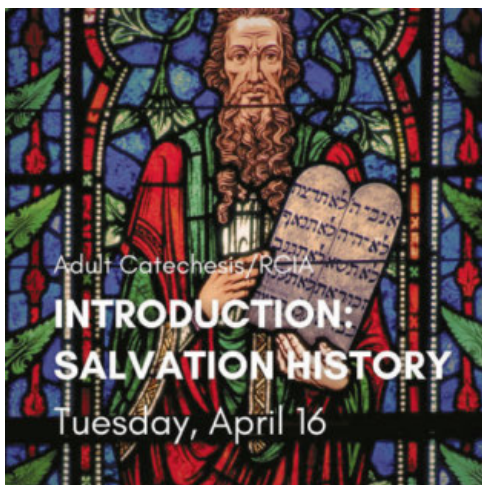

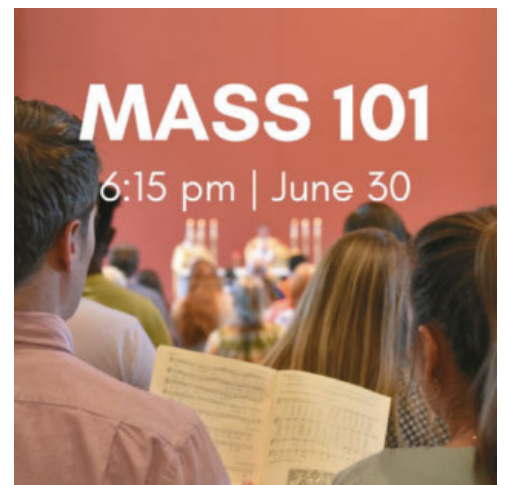

Stained-Glass Windows for St. Philip: One Window Left!

Thanks to the outstanding support of parish families, 9 of the 10 Phase I windows have already been donated!

The 10th window, depicting "The Finding of Jesus in the Temple," still awaits a donor to cover the costs of its purchase and restoration so that this scene can also be added to our church.

About Our Windows

In 2023, St. Philip's made the exciting discovery of a rare set of 14 antique Mayer windows, matching the size specifications of our church. After careful evaluation of their condition and quality, the set was purchased for our church. Originally created in the 1920s for a Connecticut parish, these windows will receive a new life and inspire a new generation of the faithful at St. Philip's. Each one represents a scene from the lives of Jesus and Mary, and all have the beautiful artistry, rich detail, and luminous colors for which the Mayer of Munich company has been famed for generations.

Although they are a close fit for the frames in our church, the Mayer windows will need some adjustments to completely fill the space, as well as cleaning, re-leading, and spot repairs. 10 of the 14 stained-glass windows from the Mayer set will be restored and placed in the window frames of our Phase I church. The remaining 4 window scenes will be installed as part of the church expansion in a later phase.
